- A technical meeting on the JRC methodology for evidence screening of chemicals developed in the context of impact assessment on criteria to identify endocrine disruptors was held in Brussels on 6 November 2015. *The SCCS Secretariat and Christophe Rousselle* participated and he reported to all members. No action from SCCS is foreseen at this stage.
