# FI PPP - Overall Aims

- ★ Leverage the internet infrastructure as an open, secure and trusted platform;
- ★ **Improve the inter-linkages between technologies and applications;**
- ★ Make business processes and operation of infrastructures and applications more efficient;
- ★ **Foster cross-sector industrial partnerships**
  - ★ involving users and public authorities at all levels: local, regional and national;
- ★ **Address regulatory and policy issues.**

# ENISA...

- ★ **Is an independent and neutral expert body;**
- ★ **Acts in areas where problems cannot be addressed through a National but rather an International (EU) approach:**
  - ★ Through the development of policy recommendations to the EC and/or EU MS;
  - ★ By assisting the EC in the implementation of certain activities;
- ★ **Leverages on established trust relations with private as well as public stakeholders;**
- ★ **Can participate in an advisory role;**

# ENISA relevant areas of interest (not exhaustive)

- ★ The goal for the future is to ensure that Europe can effectively manage the introduction of a new services with a high level of security while limiting the threats to civil liberties and privacy;
- ★ Areas of particular interest:
  - ★ New models for trust-establishment (i.e. *reputation systems, network topology, Behavioural biometrics and anomaly detection, etc.*);
  - ★ Advocating and fostering a Pan-European approach to privacy;
  - ★ The (changing) role of authentication in the information society and use and management of multiple identities in online services;
  - ★ Development of guidelines for regulatory review and interpretation;
