Open high-level launch event of the Public-Private Partnership on the Future Internet, Valencia, 14 April 2010

Opened by Francisco Ros, Spanish State Secretary of Telecommunications and Information Society and with a keynote address by [Neelie Kroes](#), Commissioner for European Digital Agenda, the conference will host a number of high-level debates on the future of the Internet, including the formal high-level launch of the European public-private partnership on the Future Internet.

FI-PPP Stakeholder consultation

In the [previous newsletter](#) we reported about the ongoing stakeholder consultations and the roadmap towards the implementation of the FI-PPP, here an update in view of the forthcoming constituency building event in Nice on 12 March.

- The consultation with a group European industry stakeholders resulted in a [public report](#) of the group.
- The R&D centres consulted in two workshop in January and February, work on a consolidated view on priorities and contributions from the European R&D centres community.
- The workshop with the representatives from the prospective FI-PPP usage areas will take place on 3 March.

The above three communities will present their work and views at the forthcoming constituency building event in Nice on 12 March, together with submissions which have been made to the [workshop website](#), see the [agenda](#).

In addition, a range of dedicated workshops have taken place at the initiative of interested Member countries (about 15). The Commission services are ready to continue supporting such workshops also in the future, should this be requested.
