

## **General comments / new developments regarding the final report.**

*Principle 1: Raise awareness of safety education messages and acceptable use policies to users, parents, teachers and carers in a prominent, clear and age-appropriate manner.*

1. In the footer of the homepage a link leads to the **Terms of Use** (« gebruiksvoorwaarden »). We will see to change this into a clickable link also for non subscribers.
2. Note: a direct link can be found at <http://www.hyves.nl/index.php?l1=ut&l2=da> where a subscriber can delete his or her account. Deactivation of a profile is not possible, when removal of the profile took place this is permanent.

## **Summary of results and Conclusion**

1. We will see if we can adapt the Terms of Use for minors.
2. *“Yet no information is provided on how compliance with this requirement is assessed.”* This last remark could be deleted as Mijnskind online and privacy watchdog CPB have declared that our current policy of removal and ip-blocking upon request by parents is sufficient.
3. *“However, no information for parents could be found on the SNS.”* This will be added to the Veilig hyven tips.
4. *“Yet, testing revealed that adults can find and have access to profiles of younger users.”* It was agreed that browsing for users younger than 16 should not be possible, this has been deactivated in the website. Searching for specific minors is still allowed.
5. *“Still these privacy options are not accompanied with awareness raising efforts to encourage users to make informed decisions.”* The default settings are an indication of the best privacy settings. We will see if further contextual advice can be given.
