In the interests of transparency, providers supporting the EU Safer Social Networking Principles agree to self declare how they have considered the Principles in relation to the Social Networking Services they offer, using the form below.

1. About the Social Networking Service(s)

The following is a brief outline of Giovani.it's declaration, including a short description of the services it offers that fall into the category of "social networking" as outlined in the Principles.

Giovani.it is a in Italy located social network with more than 2.000.000 of registered users. The target group young people 14-25 years old. Besides the strictly social network's services (blog, chat, profiles, networking) Giovani.it offers study tools designed for high school and college students.

2. How has the company considered these services in relation to the Principles?

The following is an outline of how Giovani.it has considered the EU Safer Social Networking Principles in relation to its Social Networking Service(s). This section will make reference to the recommendations made in the Principles document, where they are applicable and outline how they are applied.

Principle 1: Raise awareness of safety education messages and acceptable use policies to users, parents, teachers and carers in a prominent, clear and age appropriate manner

The Terms, Condition & Privacy Statement are always reachable from the footer. The Faq and Helpline are visible and linked on the whole social network, inside the network the Helpline get a premium position on the right top. Inside the Helpline: there are two sections with behaviour advices and explanations. One is for the users and one for the parents and teacher, both are monthly updated.

Principle 2: Work towards ensuring that services are age appropriate for the intended audience

To sign up to Giovani.it you need to provide your date of birth, underage users are collocated in a special users group. Its public behaviour, connections and profiles are daily controlled.

Principle 3: Empower users through tools and technology

Giovani.it strictly recommend to use the privacy tools on the site, we constantly work on new technical implementantions which are quickly communicated to the users.

Principle 4: Provide easy to use mechanisms to report conduct or content that violates the terms of service

Inside Giovani.it social network the Helpline is easily reachable on every page, the helpdesk staff answers daily and daily check out inappropriate content for the users

Principle 5: Respond to notifications of Illegal content or conduct

Since years [Giovani.it](#) collaborate with the police authorities for law enforcement in investigations and prosecutions

Principle 6: Enable and encourage users to employ a safe approach to personal information and privacy

[Giovani.it](#) constantly explain to all users how much is important to protect the own personal information: the [Faq](#) contains an extensive chapter about minimizing potential risks about sharing personal informations.

Principle 7: Assess the means for reviewing illegal or prohibited content/conduct

[Giovani.it](#) regularly improve the manual and automated tools which allowed to block and remove prohibited content/conduct.
