## Visions of the future: technological insights

- Technological advance is the ‘enabler’ and can trigger new opportunities to promote eInclusion
- How can it do this?
- Will it be affordable and accessible to all?
- Selected insights: mobile comms, ICT & ageing; assistive robotics; driving support systems



## Two main questions

1. Where is the technology heading?
    - How can we ensure that new ICT R&D and market developments will be accessible and affordable for all?
  2. What do we do to raise awareness?
    - How can we increase take-up of existing and emerging ICT which supports eInclusion?
