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EC Consultation Question 1:

- How can we define research data and what types of research data should be open?
- As much data as possible should be open, at least all research data from publicly funded projects.

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EC Consultation Question 2:

- When and how does openness need to be limited?
- No need to limit openness but to structure it by precise rules and regulations.

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EC Consultation Question 3:

- How should the issue of data re-use be addressed?
- By providing simple legal licenses to select from (as templates).

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EC Consultation Question 4:

- Where should research data be stored and made accessible?
- There should be centralized & de-centralized storage option but more important is the usage of standardized metadata (in particular the new international ISO metadata standard **ISO/IEC 19788**).

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EC Consultation Question 5:

- How can we enhance data awareness and a culture of sharing?
- Through development, approval and publication of European policies and the collection of good practices as well as through templates for legal issues (copyright and licensing). And ...

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EC Consultation Question 5 (cont):

- How can we enhance data awareness and a culture of sharing?
- Finally through the support of European and international initiatives for promoting Open Research and its broad application, e.g. in Open Education.
