

LAW OF 2006 ON THE RE-USE OF PUBLIC-SECTOR INFORMATION

Decree pursuant to Article 3(2)

The Minister for Finance, exercising the powers conferred to him by Article 3(2) of the Law of 2006 on the re-use of public-sector information, hereby issues the following Decree.

Summary title. 1. This Decree shall be referred to as the Decree of 2007 on the re-use of public-sector information (categorisation of documents).

Categorisation of documents. 2. The categories of documents which are held by the public sector and which can be re-used are contained in the following documents and/or publications -

(a) Statistical Service publications as recorded in the Publications Catalogue of the Statistical Service, which is also available on the Service's website, provided they are in stock;

(b) Meteorological and climatic information and data, as recorded in the publications/documents catalogue of the Meteorological Service made available on the Service's website, provided they are in stock:

(i) weather forecasts and aeronautical information,

(ii) statistical climatic product tables,

(iii) annual weather reports,

(iv) meteorological studies,

- (v) meteorological records,
 - (vi) unprocessed primary meteorological data,
 - (vii) description of weather conditions;
- (c) Government Printing Office publications, as recorded in the publications catalogue made available on its website, provided they are in stock;
- (d) geological/terrain data and maps, as recorded in the publications/documents catalogue of the Geological Survey Unit made available on its website, provided they are in stock:
- (i) memoranda,
 - (ii) reports,
 - (iii) books
 - (iv) maps,
 - (v) digital geographical information.

Charge.

3. Documents carrying a sales price at the time of entry into force of this Decree shall continue to be issued at that price, while documents for which there is no sales price shall be provided free of charge.
