## 1/ Adiba Patrick



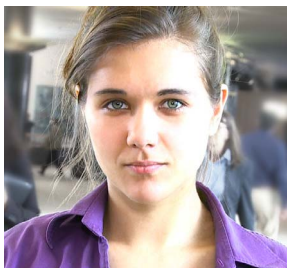

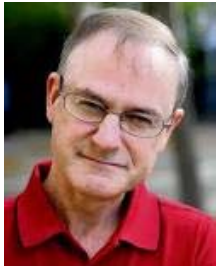
