We would like to bring to your attention the aeronautical spectrum seminar which will take place in Brussels in the afternoon of December 10th 2013.

The seminar aims to discuss present and future spectrum needs and the specific features of the aeronautical sector. Therefore, the European Commission, Eurocontrol and the Aeronautical Spectrum Frequency Consultation Group (ASFCG) warmly welcome spectrum stakeholders from non-aeronautical sectors.

The continuous increase in air traffic movements as well as the additional requirement for new and emerging applications such as unmanned aircraft systems are indeed placing increased demands on both the aviation regulatory and air traffic management mechanisms.

The seminar will consider the international context and in particular WRC-15 related issues before discussing the business implications of aeronautical spectrum. The final part of the seminar will cover the evolution and future requirements in the field of aeronautical spectrum.

The seminar is preceded, in the morning, in the same room, by a joint EC-CEPT workshop on WRC-15 (see annex). A single registration for the day covers both events.
