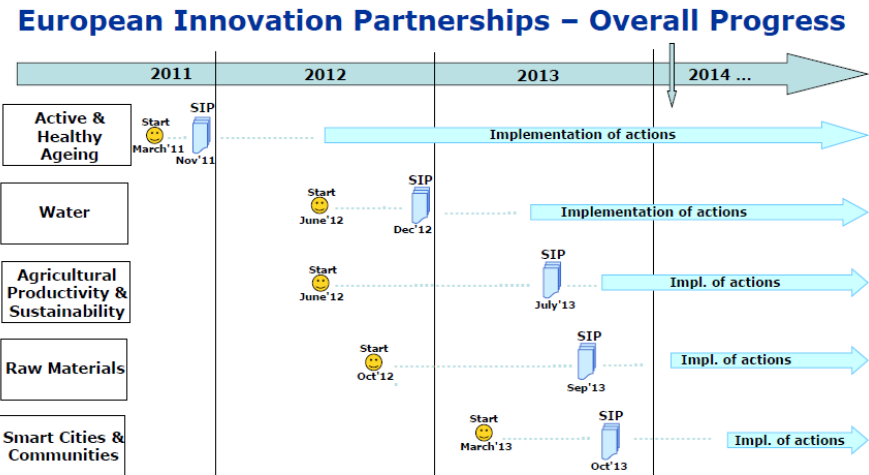

### EIP Philosophy

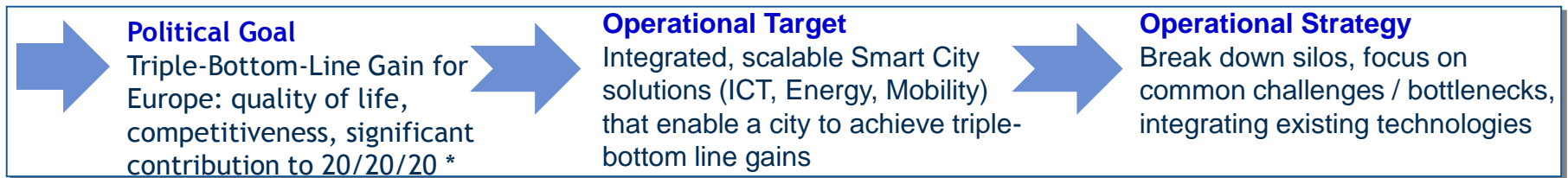
- Step up R&D efforts

### EIPs launched so far

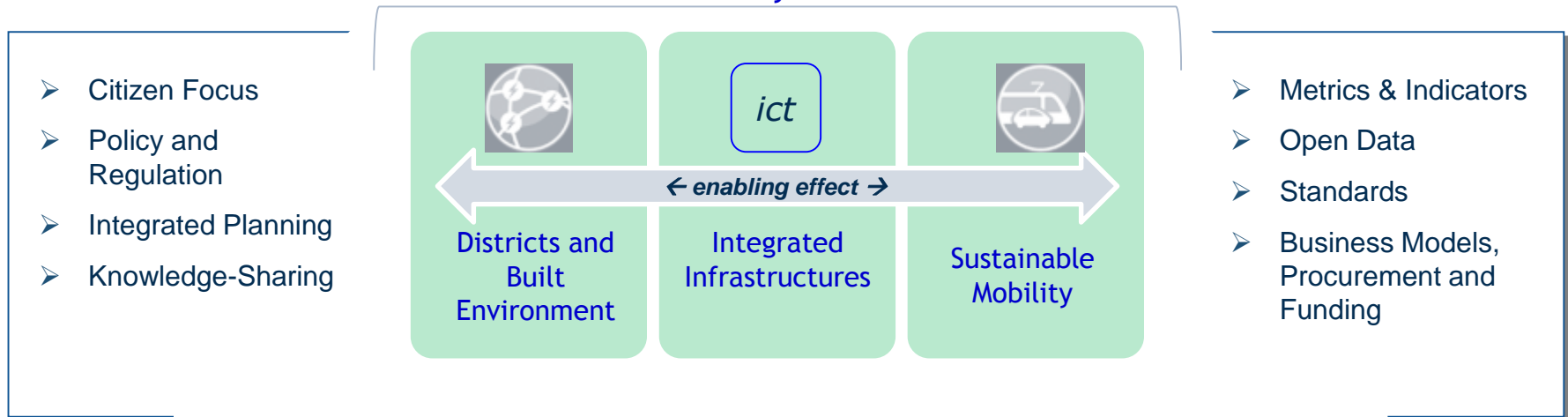


Our energy and climate challenges will be won or lost in cities. This EIP is about accelerating solutions deployment that help us answering these challenges.

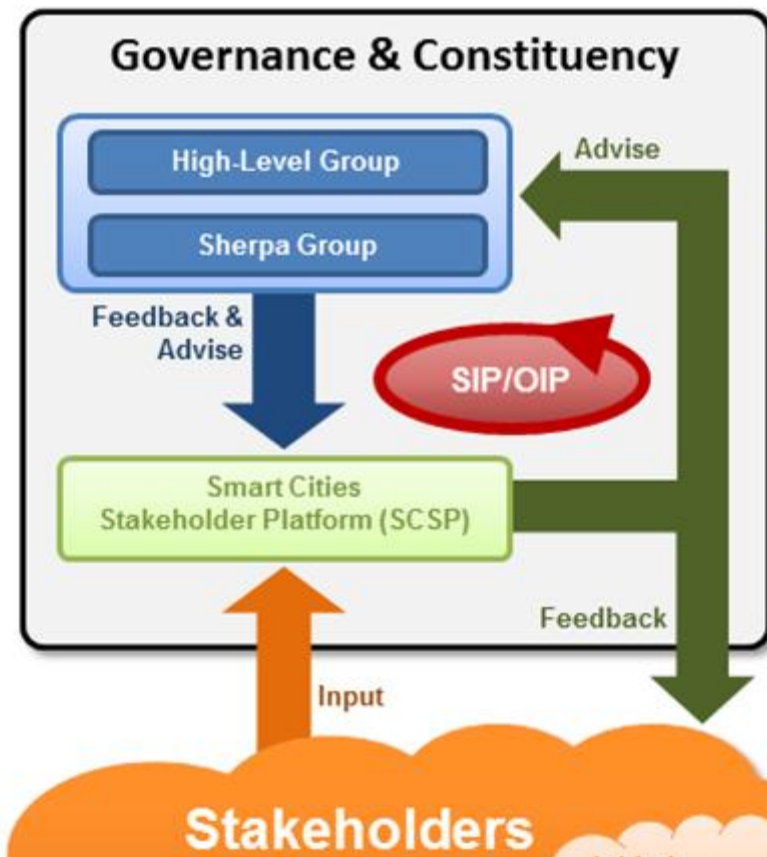


### The How

- EIP membership not a precondition for successfully applying
- Focus Area was inspired by and took full account of on-going developments in EIP

### Invitation for Commitment

- EIP's own implementation "instrument"
- Importantly different to Calls for Proposal, much lighter application process and with different goals
- No funding associated

## Smart Cities and Communities EIP - timeline

- July 2012: Commission launches EIP
- February 2013: Council welcomes initiative and supports EIP
- March 2013: 1st Sherpa meeting
- May 2013: 1st meeting of High Level Group
- October 2013: Strategic Implementation Plan approved by High Level Group
- November 2013: Launch Conference
- **December 2013: First Call for Proposals within Horizon2020 opened with a budget of about 90M€**
- **Call deadline: 07 May 2014**
- **February 2014: Invitation for Commitments launched and first public draft of Operational Implementation Plan**
- 2014 & onwards: Operational Implementation Plan v.2, general implementation, monitoring and evaluation
