Results

Initial Results

- Surveyed 118 of 514 FP7 marine projects
- Populated the EC Marine Information Sharing
 Platform with 465 exploitable results (FP7 Oceans of Tomorrow projects)
- Collected 1,190 Knowledge Outputs (October 2015 to May 2016)

In-Progress

- Analysing and Transferring Knowledge Outputs
- Building Case studies that demonstrate Value Creation
- Carrying out Training and Capacity Building

KNOWLEDGE OUTPUT

A unit of knowledge or learning generated by or through research activity. They are not limited to denovo or pioneering discoveries but may also include new methodologies/processes, adaptations, insights, alternative applications of prior know-how/ knowledge.







Recommendations



- 1. Systemised **Collection** of Knowledge Outputs
 - Populated, accessible "Information Sharing Portal"
 - Obligatory, staged upload throughout project lifetime
- 2. Expert **Analysis** on **Status** and **Potential** of Knowledge Outputs
- 3. Tailor-made **Transfer** Activities for uptake and impact
 - Centralised Knowledge Transfer support
 - Monitoring and measurement to assess value creation
