Key recommendations of Maribe

- 1. Maribe demonstrated that all MUS and MUP examined can be viable: technically and financially.
- 2. Maribe 'Business accelerator' method very beneficial for all companies participating
 - 1. 3 party validation of financial figures
 - Creation of business models and risk assessment, often neglected by the company
- 3. Maribe recommends €120 for next H2020 BG call to fund pilot projects across the range of BG sectors
