

PSI directive & French Transposition

December 2015

- Re-use of public sector information free of charge
- Only a few exceptions for administrations required to generate revenue to cover a substantial part of their costs relating to the performance of their public tasks (applies only for administrations whose main mission is the collection, production, reproduction and dissemination of public information and which are financed under 75% by public funds)
- In practice: Geographical, meteorological information

Law for a digital Republic

A whole chapter dedicated to the data-driven economy

- Automatic publication online of three categories of administrative document that may already be freely communicated on request:
- 1° those already communicated to a citizen
- 2° those set out in the list of the main reusable administrative documents
- 3° databases and data whose publication has economic, social environmental or sanitary interest

All publication online must be in an open standard, easily reusable ie. machine readable


Public service of reference data

- New public service mandate under which the government is tasked with making available and disseminating reference data to foster its re-use
- Reference data :
- 1° Are common reference to name or identify products, services, territories or persons;
 - 2° Are frequently re-used by public or private entities (other than those who detain them);
 - 3° Their re-use implies a dissemination with a high level of quality


Law for a digital Republic

- Public service of reference data: 9 databases for the moment
 - Economic information: companies and associations registries
 - Geographical information: large scale referential, cadaster, graphic parcel register, national address database, official geographical code
 - Administrative information : State administrative organisation database
 - Employment information: directory of trades and jobs
 - High level of reliability, availability and security.

The servers made available on the Internet by Etalab allow you to use the API to illustrate a research project, an economic article, to create a dynamic infographics, etc.


