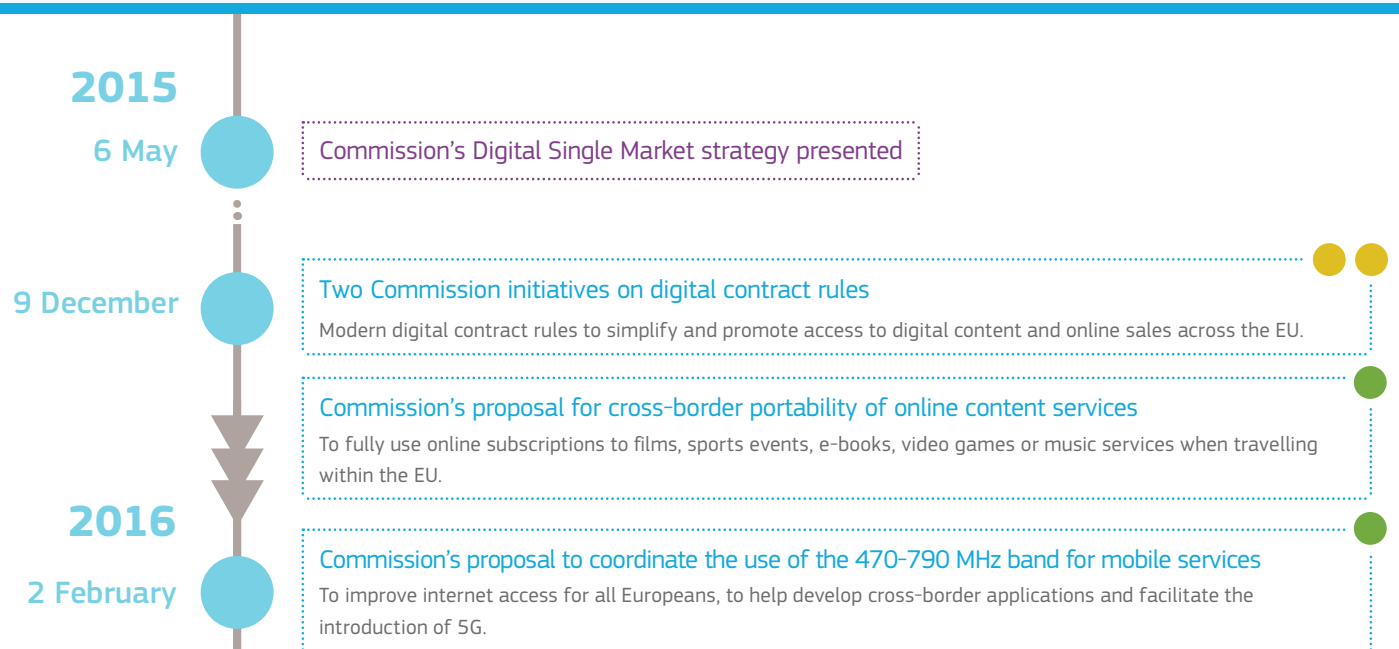
- **29** legislative initiatives presented by the European Commission since 2015

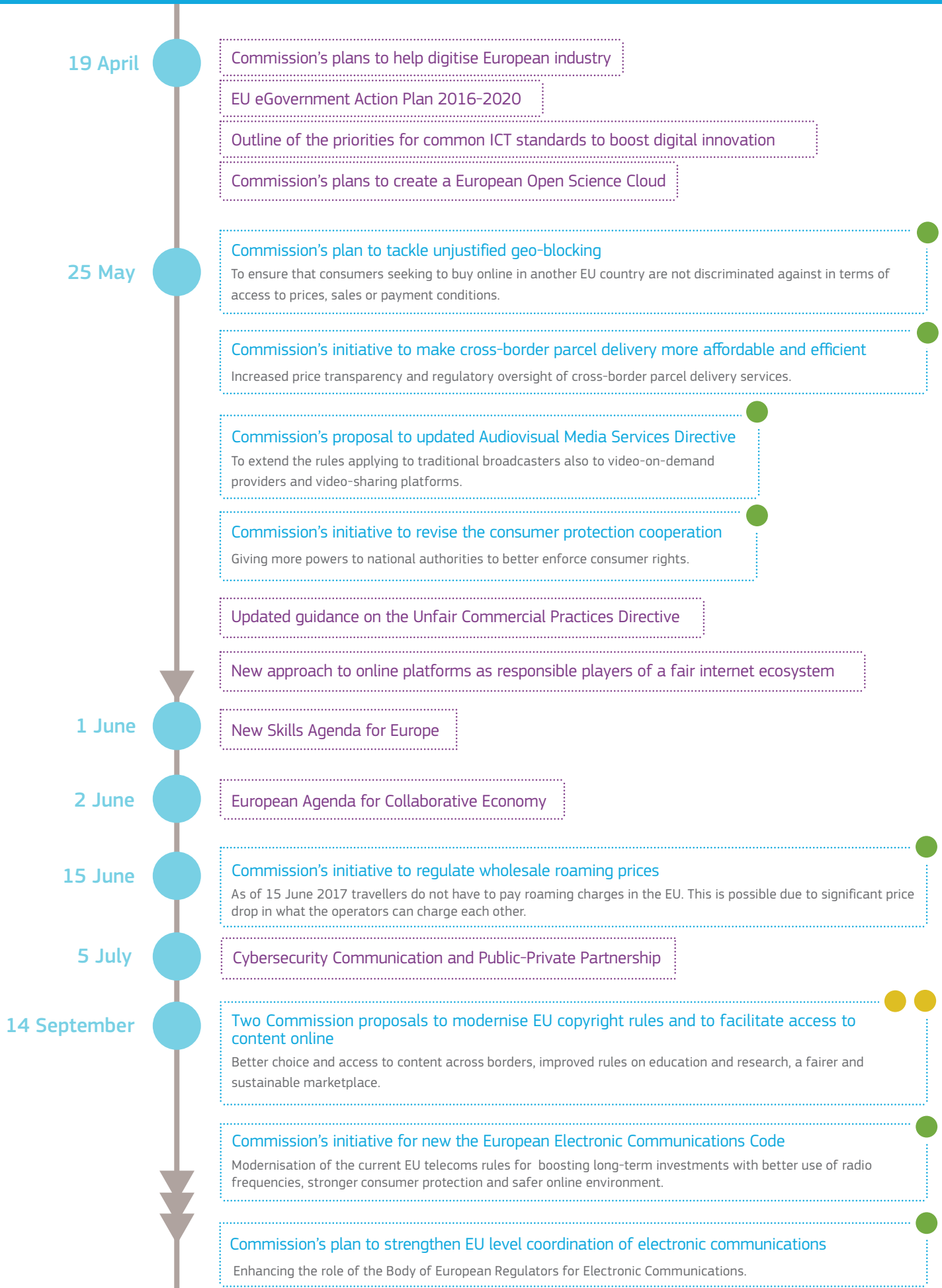

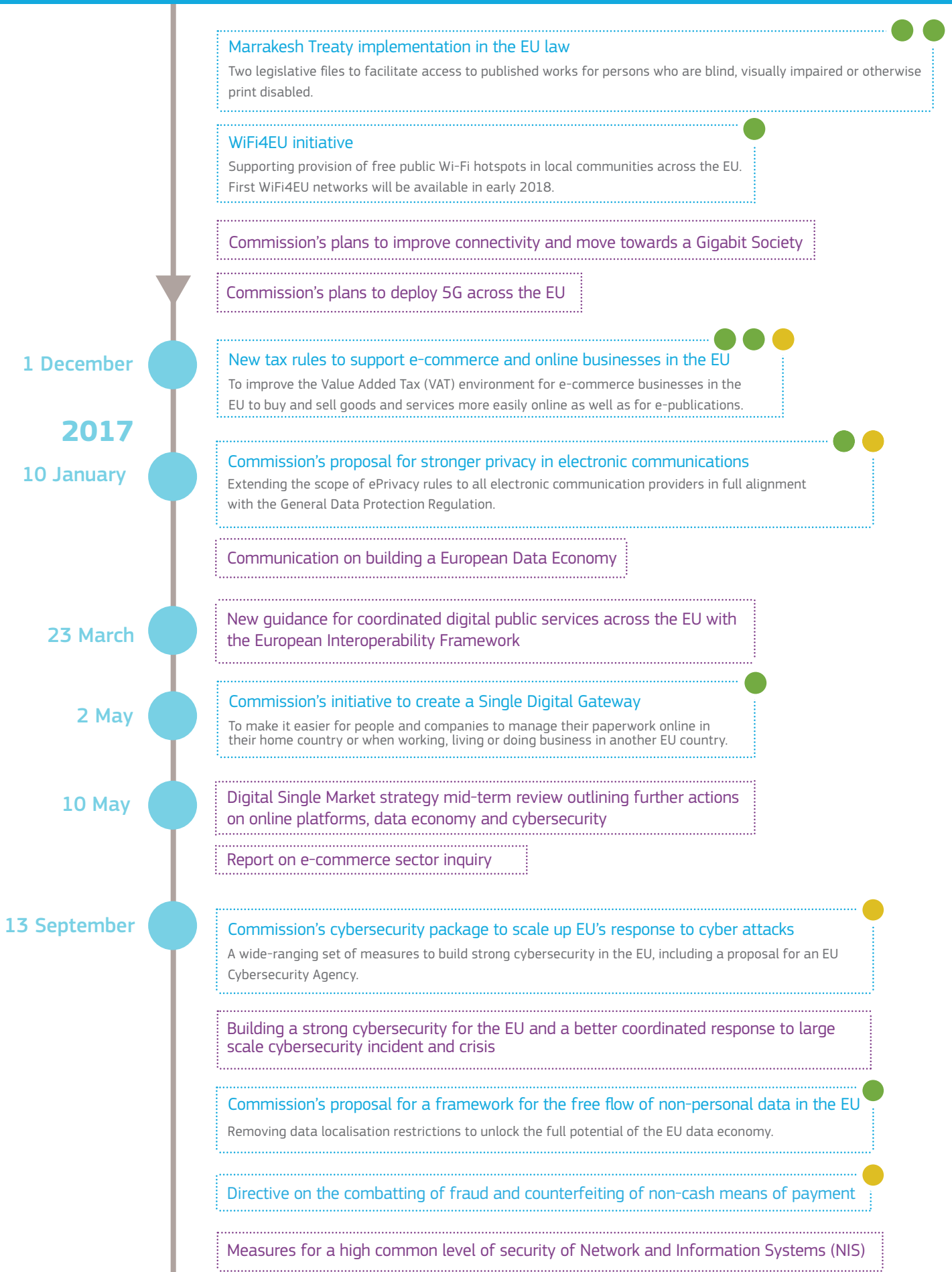
