

















Horizon 2020 and the Common Agricultural Policy (CAP)



Collectively, activities under EIP AGRI through CAP and Horizon 2020 contribute to building **Agricultural Knowledge Systems**



What is an Agricultural Knowledge and Innovation System

What:

AKIS is the organisation and interaction of persons, organisations and institutions who <u>use</u> and <u>produce</u> knowledge and innovation for agriculture and interrelated fields.

Who:

The main players of the AKIS are: farmers, advisors, researchers, farmer organisations, retailers, media, services, ministries...: they all produce and need knowledge!

Why:

The aim is to create a regional/national innovation ecosystem by enhancing knowledge flows between the AKIS players as well as strengthening links between research and practice.





Synergies between Horizon Europe and CAP+



Synergies by Design

CAP post 2020

10 bn€ allocated to R&I on food, agriculture, rural development and the bioeconomy (under Cluster 5 on Food and Natural Resources)

Continued support to multi-actor projects and Agricultural Knowledge and Innovation Systems (AKIS)

Enhanced links between R&I activities and EU policies

Knowledge, innovation, digitalisation of agriculture as **cross-cutting objective** (Art.5) and greater focus on research, technology and digitisation as **specific objective** (Art.6)

CAP Strategic Plans at regional level to include modernisation elements (Art. 95): Set-up of AKIS and development of digital technologies (Art. 102)

Main AKIS building blocks:

- Farm advisory services (Art. 13)
- EIP AGRI, operational groups (Art. 114)
- CAP networks (EU, national, regional):
 knowledge exchange, set up of OGs (Art. 113)

EIP AGRI: linking science and practice for impact



The EIP-AGRI will continue to ensure the links and pool funding sources from Horizon Europe and CAP Rural Development to foster competitive and sustainable farming and forestry.
