

In response to your questionnaire I feel it is important to note that traffic management/traffic shaping/quality of service should never be allowed to block, limit or prohibit certain types of traffic. Prioritization might sometimes be needed (such as real-time traffic vs. non-real-time traffic), but hard limitations on ports, protocols or applications should be forbidden by law. This is the only way to guarantee an open and free internet in Europe.
