- other areas and cafeterias for meetings

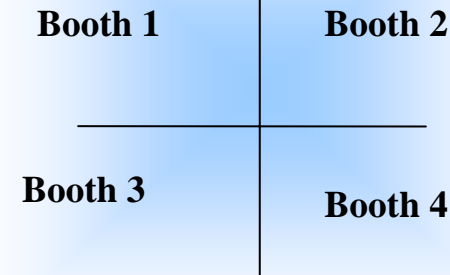
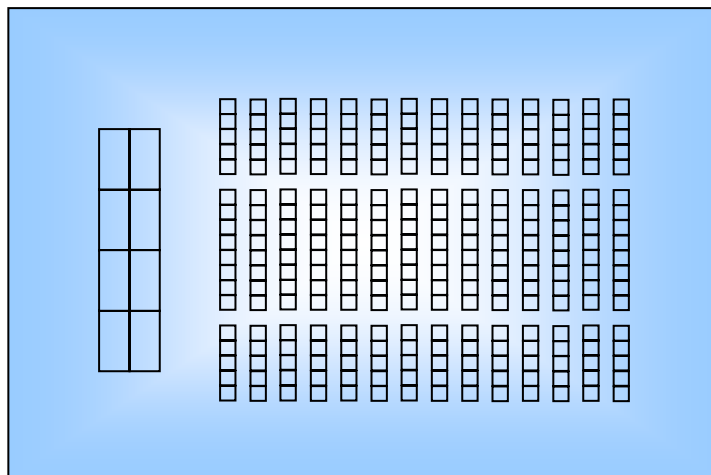
