Main responsibilities:

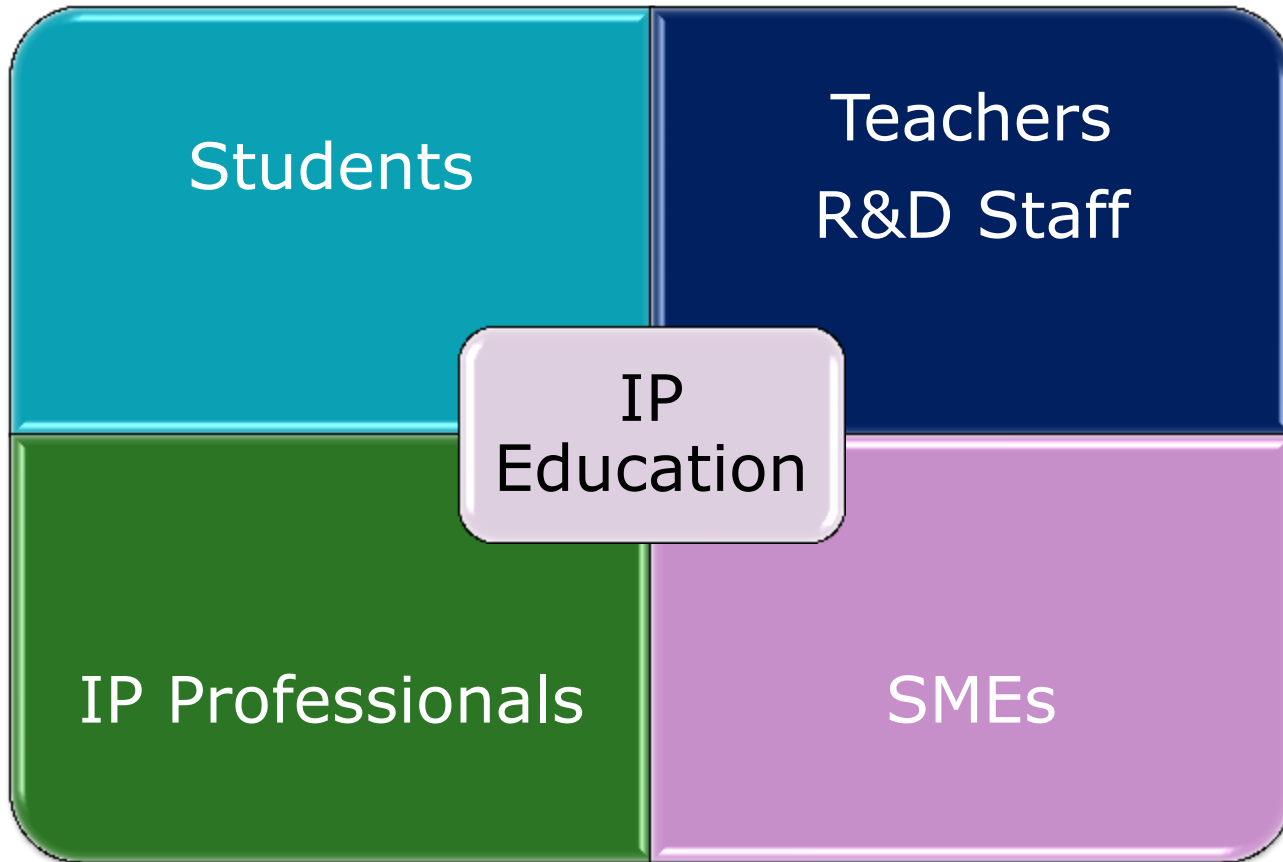
- receiving applications of industrial property objects,

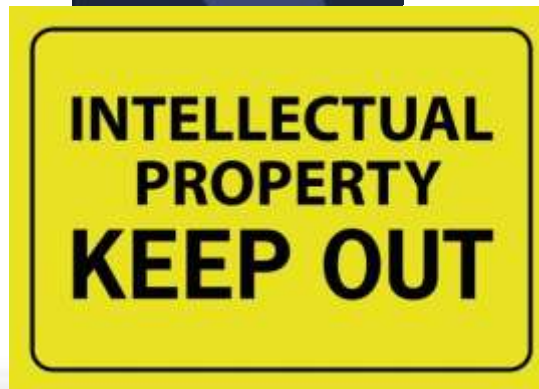
Raising awareness on IP

- wide range of conferences, workshops and trainings (e.g. Krakow Symposium, IP Day, TTO seminars, campaign „Girls go Polytechnic!”)



Raising awareness on IP

- competitions for the best postdoctoral, doctoral, master's and student's theses and artistic poster on the subject of intellectual property protection



Raising awareness on IP

- free brochures, publications and promotional materials



Dissemination of IP knowledge in academic and scientific sector

- introduction of obligatory subject „IP protection” into the syllabuses at higher education level;
- preparation of educational materials for universities and academies (in cooperation with Warsaw University, Jagiellonian University and Kielce University of Technology);
- cooperation with Warsaw University and Maria Curie-Skłodowska University in Lublin in the field of establishing postgraduate studies of intellectual property protection for future lecturers of this subject;
- cooperation with the Ministry of Science and Higher Education and the Committee of Evaluation of Scientific Units at the development of parameters used for the assessment of scientific bodies with reference to obtaining industrial property rights;
- inclusion of innovativeness and IP protection as the assessment criteria in the prestigious ranking of universities and academies prepared by Education Foundation “Perspektywy” and “Rzeczpospolita” newspaper .



Forecasted activities

- PPO's knowledge platform;
- seminars for business support entrepreneurs and institutions;
- consulting services for entrepreneurs;
- new publications.



Systemic project

Supporting the effective use of industrial property in innovative economy within the framework of the Innovative Economy Operational Programme.

- Main goal of the project: enhancing the role of industrial property rights in the Polish economy growth;
- Specific goals: enhancing the level of knowledge on industrial property protection and effective management of intangible assets; promoting Polish achievements in the field of industrial property protection;
- Target group: entrepreneurs (especially micro, small and medium sized enterprises) and the business support institutions;
- Implementation period: 2010-2015.
