This was the reason for her organization to join the “Naples 2.0: International Social Innovation Competition” organized by Euclid Network, UniCredit Foundation and Project Ahead. Her message is that social innovation has to happen now to secure a prosperous future for her generation.

The first production of her company was “Possibilità Reali” putting on the stage the stories of Camorra’s victims.
