The editor's corrections are visible in the enclosed version only if you have Track changes switched on in Word XP and “Final Showing Markup”.

- The sections of text or individual words which the editor has deleted or inserted are in one colour only. The actual colour will depend on your own PC's setting for Track changes.
- If there are sections of text highlighted in yellow or green, this indicates that the editor was unsure of the desired meaning, and you are advised to check these passages and make them clearer. To get rid of the yellow/green highlighting, highlight the yellow/green portion once more and click on the yellow/green highlighter in the toolbar.

If you wish to accept any or all of the suggested revisions, you can do so by using the toolbar in Track changes (Accept changes) or by positioning the cursor on the marked portion of text, right-clicking and selecting "accept change" or "delete change".
