

## **Tender No PO/2011-33-DUB**

### **16 December:**

**Q.** I have an enquiry about the above tender. I am a broadcast journalist with eight years experience, the majority of that time with Radio Kerry. I now periodically with the station and am interested in applying for the above tender.

**A.** With regard to your questions I'd like to refer you first and foremost to the tender specifications which you should read carefully. Furthermore please see the answers below:

**Q.** Is there a specification as to where the successful candidate should be located?

**A.** There is no specification regarding the location.

**Q.** I am familiar with the burli and radiomation systems, I presume I would need to have one or both of those systems? Is that something that the commission would financially support?

**A.** As stated in the technical specifications, the Contractor must possess the necessary infrastructure and resources for the satisfactory execution of the work. (see point 3.4 of the tender specifications)

**Q.** I note that in the information documents, I would be required to transmit three pieces of audio, do they come from Brussels, or how are they received to the successful tender?

**A.** The Contractor has to produce three audio clips a week. You may outline what you propose in this regard in your offer.

**Q.** What are the other requirements, in terms of news output, i.e. reports, copy, voicers, packages?

**A.** Please see point 3.3 of the tender specifications. There are no additional requirements.

**Q.** Is the candidate responsible for marketing the content to local and community stations?

**A.** Yes, see point 3.2 and 3.3 of the tender specifications.

**Q.** Also if my financial tender is under €37,500 then I do not need to register for VAT, is that acceptable to the commission?

The Contractor has to comply with the Irish law. Please note that the size of the contract is between €30.000 and €40.000 (see point 7 of the tender specifications).
