# MASTER IN EUROPEAN STUDIES

## The Process of Building Europe 2011-2012

### Overview

The European Union, "united in diversity", represents a reality providing young people a wide area of professional realization, as well as new opportunities going beyond the standard national boundaries. In order to face successfully the challenges involved in such a new dimension, it is necessary to gain a stock of professional knowledge with regard to the different cultural approaches present in Europe, adopting a multilingual, interdisciplinary and international teaching method.

Opened in 2000 in order to satisfy such educational needs, the Master in European Studies "The Process of Building Europe" is based on a network including 15 European Universities and it is organised by CRIE, a Jean Monnet Centre of Excellence, University of Siena. The project offers the opportunity to access to the different *poles of excellence* with regard to European Studies, as well as to participate in internships at institutions, research centres and companies selected by the partner Universities.

### Didactic Organisation

The Master's Course runs for one year and is organised in three modules, including lectures, seminars, simulations, conferences, tests and a final thesis (60 ECTS).
