

Prof.dr.ir. Niko Wijmolst

Chairman of the Dutch Maritime Network since 1997, full professor (shipping innovation) at Euromed Management, Marseille, visiting professor at business schools/universities in London, Copenhagen, Rotterdam and Antwerp; supervisory board member of various maritime companies, chairman/member of four maritime innovation platforms, chairman European Network of Maritime Clusters.

From 1988-2000 part-time professor (shipping) at the Delft University of Technology (TUD), before that period nine years in the private sector (Furness, Rotterdam en Thyssen-Bornemisza, London). After his study at the TUD (civil engineering, 1970) and military service, he worked as assistant professor at the TUD, where he obtained his doctorate degree in 1977. In between he worked in Kenya for the Ministry of Works.

He published many articles and (co-)authored 20 maritime books. His most recent textbook *Shipping Innovation* was published in December 2008.
