

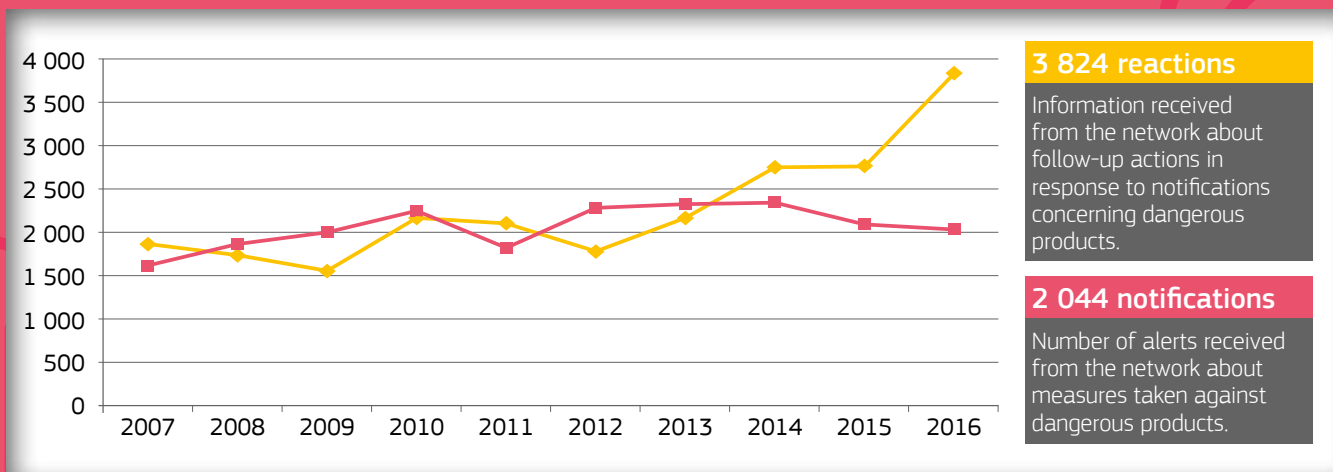

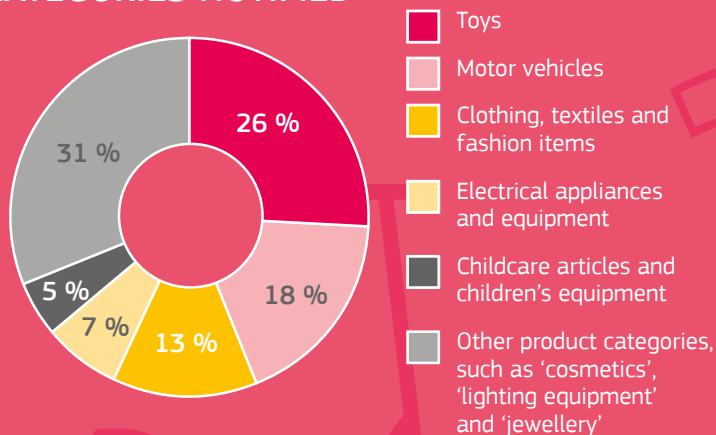

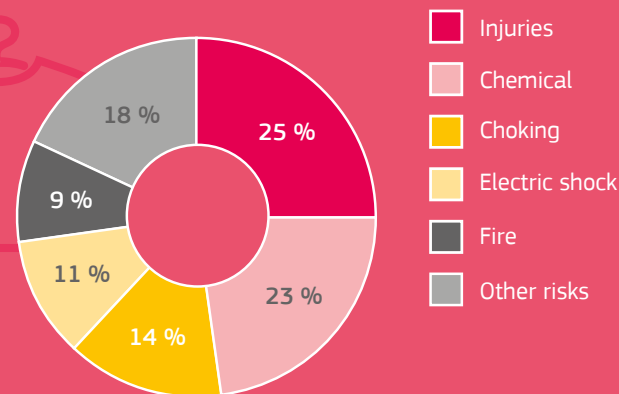
MAIN TRENDS IN 2016

In 2016, the number of reactions was almost double the number of notifications on dangerous products. This means that national authorities are, increasingly, following up on notifications on dangerous products circulated in the system and more and more measures are being taken around Europe to stop these products.
