HUNGARIAN APPROACH TO URBAN CLLD

- Priority Axis 7 of Territorial and Settlement Development Operational Programme 2014-2020 (TSDOP)
- Main purposes:
 - Development of cultural and community spaces and services
 - Strengthening local identity
 - Enhance local community participation and awareness in order to develop local and community based economies
 - Program based bottom-up development at urban level
- New instrument:
 - Local development programs use simultaneously and in a coordinated manner ERDF and ESF

HUNGARIAN APPROACH TO URBAN CLLD

- Focus on less developed regions (Central Hungary is not included)
- Towns where the population more than 10 000
- Total budget: 147, 2 million EUR
- Available fund depends on the population of the town (min. 0,8 million EUR):
 - 10 001 – 18 000: 1,61 million EUR
 - 18 001 – 60 000: 2,57 million EUR
 - 60 001 – 150 000: 4,84 million EUR

HUNGARIAN APPROACH TO URBAN CLLD

- Implementation of Local Community Development Strategies
- Forms of LAGs:
 - consortium or association
- The ratio of ERDF to ESF is 2 : 1
 - ERDF: development of cultural and community spaces
 - ESF: local community activities
- Running costs: 15% of the budget
- Key projects: 40% of the budget (without running cost)

HUNGARIAN APPROACH TO URBAN CLLD

- End of the last application period:
 - 18 September 2017
- Result:
 - 60 already supported LAGs
 - Additional 50 Strategies under evaluation
 - Approximately 100 LAGs will be selected
- Start of the implementation:
 - First local projects in February 2018
