## **QUESTIONS**

Call for tenders: Counterfactual Impact Evaluation of Cohesion policy: Work Package1: examples from enterprise support (No 2010.CE.16.B.AT.042).

I would like to kindly ask you for clarification of the tender specification (4) Organisation of the Evaluation, p9. Does the word "evaluator" means "tenderer" in all occurencies? and therefore, 1 person from the side of the consortium will attend 3 meetings of the steering group. In addition, one or more persons will attend kick-off meeting. the evaluator/tenderer will suggest 2 additional experts (costs of 2 experts attending 2 meetings to be introduced within financial proposal).

## **ANSWERS / REPONSES**

Yes, in all cases, the evaluator is the succesful tenderer and should perform all the tasks you list, as required by the terms of reference.

You should note that "evaluator" refers not to one individual, but to the legal entity conducting the evaluation. So the ToR does not limit attendance at the steering group to just 1 person if the tenderer considers a broader team to be appropriate.
