## **QUESTIONS**

With reference to the call for tenders displayed in the subject of this e-mail (no 2010.CE.16.0.AT.054), I would like to kindly enquire a clarification in respect to the declaration of honour and supporting documents and certificates.

Namely, in the model letter is noted that supporting documents for cases a, b, d & e, are requested at the stage of submitting the tender, whereas in the invitation, article 12 and regarding evidence in respect to the exclusion criteria, is noted that the aforementioned documents should be submitted within 10 days before signing the contract.

Please, do clarify if I should attach the supporting documents to the declaration at the tender stage, and in that case if it is accepted to submit them in Greek (as the courts and professional bodies etc issue those certificates and documents in Greek).

## **ANSWERS / REPOSES**

For the first step of the procedure, a **declaration on honour** is enough to assess the exclusion criteria. Only the tenderer to whom the contract will be awarded will have to submit the documentary evidence.

Regarding the language, the supporting documents can be submitted in all official languages of the European Union.
