
QUESTIONS

With reference to the following statement in the specifications of the call for tenders by open procedure n° 2011.CE.16.0.AT.009:

"The database should use ACCESS 2010/2007 (or a equivalent application compatible with Microsoft Office). The work could use the existing database or create a new one." (page 6-7)

We have the following question:

Currently, the data base, developed within the framework of the data feasibility study, is secured and for this reason, attempts to having a clear view on the structure and choices behind it are hampered. In addition, since the data base was developed within the framework of ERDF we assume that this information should be freely available.

In order to assess the feasibility and desirability to use the existing data base or to create a new one, it is necessary to have access to the structure of the current data base.

Therefore, our question is whether the current data base can be provided unsecured to the tenderers.
