Professional Activity. He is a Tenured Professor of Criminal Law at the University of the Basque Country (from 1988 to 1996 at the University of La Laguna). He is the Director of the Inter-University Chair BBVA Foundation - Provincial Government of Biscay in Law and the Human Genome, University of Deusto (since 1993) and The University of the Basque Country (since 1997).

He has been an Assistant, Adjunct and Professor at the University of Zaragoza (1974-1987), Founder and Director of the Centre for Criminology Studies (1990-1996) and Dean of the Law School (1991-1994) of the University of La Laguna.

He has also been an Acting Judge of the Territorial High Court of Zaragoza (1987/88).

Education.

He is a Graduate in Law (1974), holds a Doctorate in Law (1980) and is a Doctor of Medicine (1991) by the University of Zaragoza. He has a High Diploma in Criminology (1974) by the Complutense University of Madrid. He holds university language degrees in English and German.

To further his studies and scientific research, he has been several times abroad, at Universities such as: Bonn, Munich, Lüneburg, Paris II, Stanford

(California), Max-Planck Institute for Foreign and International Criminal Law in Freiburg im Breisgau and the Kennedy Institute of Ethics at Georgetown University (Washington, D.C.).

Research Activity.

His research activities have been focused towards the following areas: the Dogmatism of Criminal Law (for example, the theory of error of prohibition, consent, danger of the action, subjective intent- wilful and negligent, offences arising out of omission, capacity, conscientious acts), Dangerousness and Criminal Law, Criminal Law and the modern Information and Communication Technologies, Criminal Law in relation to Biomedicine, Genetics and Biotechnology, etc.

He has directed several research projects (some still underway), on behalf of the Spanish Ministry of Education and Science, the Ministry of Health and Consumption, the Ministry of Science and Technology, the Government of the Canary Islands, the Basque Government (12 total), the European Commission (Spanish Coordinator in ten: general coordinator in one) and has collaborated in eight more. On behalf of the Council of Europe, he has specifically taken part in a collective project on *Le Médecin et les Droits de l'Homme* ("Medicine and Human Rights", CEDAM, Padova, 1990) and he directed and was a speaker at the XXII Colloquium of European Law concerning "The Civil and Criminal responsibility of the professional" (La Laguna, 1992).

He has been recognised with **five six-year terms of research** (1976-2005) by the National Evaluation Commission of Research Activity. Likewise, the University of the Basque Country has recognised nine terms of teaching, research and service activity (the most established), which recognises him as an **“Excellent Professor”** at the University.

Teaching Activity.

He regularly teaches courses on Criminal Law, General Criminal Law and Special Offences, Genetics and Criminal Law, Bioethics, Law and the Human Genome and Cyber crime. He has six quinquennium teaching terms officially recognised.

His training and experience in long distance and virtual education: He has been officially recognised as having the qualification as an *on-line* teaching and tutorship Professor by the University of the Basque Country. He is co-director, coordinator (Law Module) and professor of the *on-line* Inter-

University Masters of Bioethics of the Canary Islands (2003-05; The University of the Basque Country joins for the course of 2005-07) and teaches several courses in the Virtual Campus of the University of the Basque Country (since 2001). He frequently participates in postgraduate courses in virtual platforms and in-person classes and in radio and television sessions at the UNED.

He has participated in numerous European and International Post-graduate and Quality Programs. He has been a member (2. Gutachten) of two evaluating commissions of doctoral thesis (*Promotion*) in Germany (University of Lüneburg, 2004). He has been an invited or visiting Professor of several European, Latin American and Asian Universities, where he has taught undergraduate as well as graduate courses.

He has directed thirteen doctoral theses and co-directed another.

Activities as an Expert, Consultant and Assessor.

He has collaborated and collaborates at present with the Spanish Ministry of Justice, Ministry of Health and Consumption, the World Health Organisation, The UNESCO, the Council of Europe and the European Commission (several General Directorates). He is a scientific consultant for the Italian Ministry of Universities and Research, of the Community of Trento and assessor for the National Agency for Evaluation and Prospective Research (ANEP, since 1999), of the FIS (1995-98); he is a member of the Advisory Committee on Law of the National Evaluation Commission on Research Activity (1988-00).

He was invited by the European Commission and the Council of Europe to become a member of a group of advisors to provide assistance to the Ministry of Justice and the Parliament of the Democratic Republic of Albania in the drafting of the new Criminal Code and the Law of Criminal Procedure, within the framework Programme called "Task Force Albania" (1993/1995). He authored a confidential report, by special request of the Council of Europe, entitled "Shortcomings in the Functioning of the Judicial System in Spain".

He authored the draft bill of the current Spanish Law on Extraction and Organ Transplants of 1979 and has collaborated with regard to these matters with the Spanish Ministry of Health and Consumption (preparatory works on Royal Decrees 480/1980 and 2070/1999). He was part of the work group responsible for the draft bill on Biomedical Research for the Ministry of Health, participating in the drafting of a summary. He has also worked as a counsellor in the draft bill of the new Law on Assisted Reproduction Techniques. He has

worked on both cases as a representative of the Ministry of Justice. He has counselled this Ministry on the Criminal Code Project of 2006.

He is a member of the National Commission on Assisted Human Reproduction as proposed by the Autonomous Communities (1997-2003) and by the Ministry of Justice (2004-), a member of the Follow-up and Control Commission on the Donation and Use of Cells and Human Tissue (2004-), President of the Ethics Committee on Clinical Research of the Autonomous Community of the Basque Country (2005-). He was President of the Ethics Committee on Clinical Research of the Hospital of the Canary Health Service of Santa Cruz de Tenerife (1995-2000). He was a member of the Advisory Committee on Ethics of the Ministry of Science and Technology (2002-05). He is a personal adviser to the Minister of Health and Consumption in Law and Bioethics (2005-).

He has appeared in several commissions or addresses in the Parliament and the Senate and mixed commissions (five since 1979), with proposals for legal reforms, including the Criminal Code.

He is a member of the Directing Committee on Bioethics (Legal Affairs Directorate) of the Council of Europe (2006-).

He is a member of the Counselling Committee on Ethics of the World Health Organisation for the Human Genome (HUGO) (2005-).

Congresses

He has participated in numerous national and international Congresses, Seminars and Symposiums throughout Spain and Europe (Austria, Albania, Bosnia, Switzerland, Denmark, France, Germany, Gibraltar, Hungary, Italy, Ireland, Norway, Netherlands, Czech Republic and the United Kingdom), Asia (Indonesia, Israel, Japan, Thailand), Africa (Egypt), North America (Canada, USA) and Latin America (Argentina, Brazil, Colombia, Chile, Costa Rica, Mexico, Peru and Uruguay). He has been the organizer or director of some of these.

He has collaborated with the Pontifical Academy of Sciences (Vatican City) as organiser and speaker in two sessions (1993 and 1994), as co-editor of a book (1996) and as co-author (1996,1997).

He is a member of the science committee, advisory board or editorial committee of Spanish, European and Latin-American science reviews (22) as well as advisor to several Scientific Associations and Institutions (19).

Awards and honours.

He has received the Extraordinary Doctorate in Law Award (1981), the Award of the Royal Academy of Medicine of Zaragoza (1983), International Science of Man Award (Barcelona, 1985) and Fundesco Essay Award (Madrid 1987).
