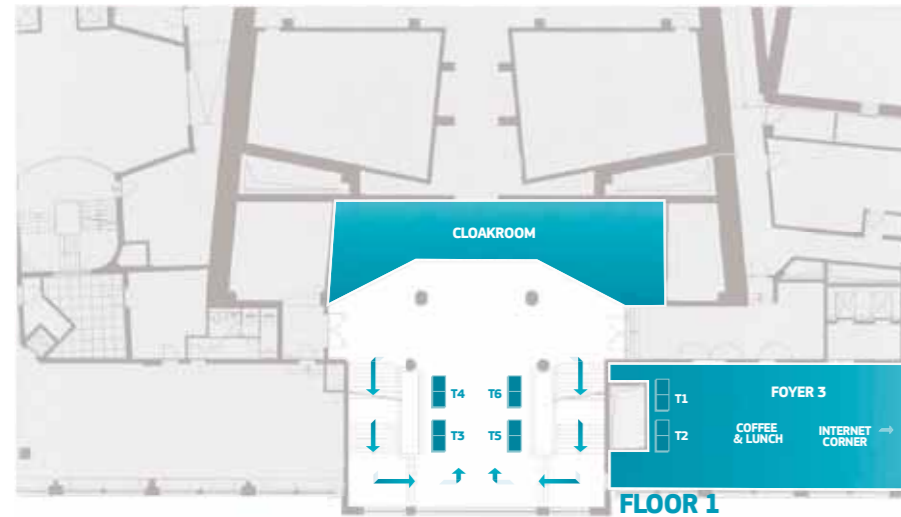

«INNOVATION IN HEALTHCARE WITHOUT BORDERS» IS THE THIRD EDITION OF THE «INNOVATION IN HEALTHCARE» CYCLE OF CONFERENCES.

The main objective of this series of events is to act as a policy forum for innovation in healthcare, involving key actors and policy-makers in order to identify major challenges and build consensus to address them; assess progress to date and develop initiatives and opportunities for innovation in healthcare.

The two previous conferences in 2010 and 2011 provided sound contributions to the Innovation Union Communication and to the Commission proposal for Horizon 2020 respectively. The 2012 conference will provide the opportunity to contribute shaping the next steps forward, including the adoption of H2020 and beyond.

«Innovation in Healthcare without Borders» is jointly organized by several parts of the European Commission: Directorates-General for Research and Innovation, Enterprise and Industry, Health and Consumers, Regional Policy, Development and Cooperation, in consultation with other relevant Directorates-General and major stakeholders, namely European Federation of Pharmaceutical Industries and Associations (EFPIA), European Biopharmaceutical Enterprises (EBE), European Association for Bioindustries (EuropaBio), European Medical Technology Association (EUCOMED), European Diagnostic Manufacturers Association (EDMA), European Hospital and Healthcare Federation (HOPE), European Patients Forum (EPF), Council of European Bioregions (CEBR), Association of European Science and Technology Transfer Professionals (ASTP), Tech Transfer Summit (TTS Ltd), International Venture Club/European Venture Contest, Research & Innovation Management Services, the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD), Special Programme for Research and Training in Tropical Diseases (TDR), World Health Organisation (WHO).

The agenda consisting of a number of plenary and parallel sessions provides substantial space for debate among panelists, involving also the audience.

It will be complemented by a small «fair» where associations and support structures will have the possibility to provide information to the participants.
