Workshop: Biomaterials for Health

The Directorate-General for Research and Innovation of the European Commission will hold a special workshop dedicated to future research and development opportunities involving biomaterials and their place in the healthcare field.

The Workshop will take place in Brussels on March 16, 2012 from 9.30h until 16.30h – Piet Mondrian building (CDMA), Rue du Champ de Mars 21, B-1050 Brussels.

The purpose of the workshop is to review new areas of potential clinical application. This would be to generate and/or validate (a) specific biomaterial(s) or a suitable combination thereof, for use in new therapeutic interventions (e.g. Advanced Therapy Medicinal Products, Medical Device, others to be confirmed).

Another objective would be to define those clinical conditions that would be ripe for application. This might comprise amongst others and for example, Alzheimer's, Stroke, Myocardial infarction and neurological disorders.

The end result would help to contribute to an outline strategy for the Horizons 2020 Research Programme. Potentially interested participants would include industry, the SME sector, academia, venture capital and private equity investment specialists.
