



Towards a coordinated call between the EU and Japan on "Fundamental properties of novel superconducting materials"

Japanese-EU workshop, 1 August 2010, Washington DC (USA)

The European Commission and the Japan Science and Technology Agency (JST) services are working at a coordinated call for proposals to support research on the fundamental properties of novel superconducting materials. This initiative is also expected to lead to more robust European – Japanese research cooperation.

The final decision is still pending. Interested researchers in EU and Japan are invited to liaise and network in view of elaborating possible coordinated research proposals.

To this purpose, a Japanese-EU workshop will take place on 1 August 2010 in Washington DC, back-to-back to the Applied Superconductivity Conference (ASC 2010). This workshop, organised by the Japan Science and Technology Agency wants to promote Japanese-EU scientific exchange in the field of "Superconductivity" and exploring possibilities of coordinated research between Japanese and European researchers.
