The Directorate-General for Research and Innovation of the European Commission is organising a workshop on 'Technology and market perspective for future Value Added Materials'.

The Workshop will take place in Brussels on March 14, 2012 from 9.30h until 16.30h – Piet Mondrian building (CDMA), Rue du Champ de Mars 21, B-1050 Brussels.

The workshop will bring together venture capital and private equity investment specialists and research policy makers and is intended to provide an overview and future perspective of the commercial market possibilities for value-added and value-adding materials and to set out the various technical and economic scenarios linked to their potential development and use. There will be time for networking and discussion of current objectives and strategies, as for giving recommendations for possible future research policies in this area. The European Commission recently published a study on the same topic which will be a basis for the workshop.
