## SwafS-14-2018-2019: Supporting the development of territorial Responsible Research and Innovation

- **Territory:** any area characterised by certain geographical features, or shared cultural, environmental or economic ties.
- Bring R&I actors together to integrate RRI into regional development policies and develop new transparent working methods and governance relations: **1)** map current ecosystem, **2)** reflect on how to make more inclusive, **3)** place in larger frameworks, **4)** develop concrete actions (e.g. ICs and governance changes).
- Focus activities in more than one territory. Local and regional authorities should be active partners.
- Avoid duplicating activities of Smart Specialisation Platforms and consider previous projects' findings/good practices (e.g. Online-S3, SEiSMIC)
- **Impacts:** Sustainable ICs, evaluate impacts (e.g. economic, social, scientific), contribute to one or more MoRRI/SDG indicators
