- Citizen science "covers a range of different levels of participation: from raising public knowledge about science, encouraging citizens to participate in the scientific process by observing, gathering and processing data, right up to setting scientific agenda and co-designing and implementing science-related policies".
- All scientific disciplines and the humanities are welcome.
- RIA (multiple projects in 2019): <u>Hands-on citizen science done by and with citizens</u>.
- Impact: New knowledge and innovations, evaluation data on benefits...

Support for Third Parties ("cascading grants"): beneficiaries <u>may</u> provide support to third parties as described in part K of the General Annexes.

International co-operation encouraged

Additional dissemination obligations: consortia <u>must</u> make active efforts to freely share, in a timely manner <u>and as appropriate</u>, the research strategies, methodologies, and raw and analysed data deriving from their activities (including any evaluation activities), with the other projects funded by SWAFS subject to these same obligations.
