Bulgarian door to Europe (Rousse): exhibitions (drawings, culture and history in creative researchers' work, history of Rousse), guided tour tracing historical cities in the region, round table "outstanding researchers in the memory of Rousse, concert "Rousse Municipality respects researchers", musical and entertaining party with researchers " what fun"

Marine history traditions: tradition in marine education, photos exhibition "the black sea coast, cradle of ancient cultural traditions",...

Science cafés "mystery of the oldest gold in the world", guided tours in universities and museums, ball with researchers, music, poetry, dance dedicated to sea and marine tradition
