Workshops: *art-oriented*: architect, city planner space creator, sculpting workshops, how was the city created?, architectural education...; *dance-oriented*: healthy soul in healthy body, folk dance, cat and mouse play, everybody dances salsa, merenge; *science-oriented*: you are also Einstein, let's make a robot, how to create an Internet site?, how to become a superb mathematician...

Competitions: *art-oriented*: draw a researcher, young architect contest, European town of XXII century, architectural objects...*science-oriented*: make a nano sweet, aerodynamic golf, guessing name (chemical competition)...

Demos and presentations by researchers: spectacular *physics* phenomena (aerodynamics, mechanics, acoustics, electricity and magnetism, optics...) *chemistry* (garden of secrets, star wars, what does Ramses say?) *computer* (how is a computer game created, virtual reality, multimedia presentations, rapid prototyping technique, flexible production lab, nano researcher...) *interactive television* presentation, grid technologies...

Lectures, seminars, debates: the city I live in, the city I would like to live in, Poznan seen by its architectural students, universe final border, vibro acoustic disease, explosion, why is it worthwhile to become a researcher

Guided tours in labs: Materials Technology Institute, Technology and chemical engineering, electrical power engineering, Poznan supercomputing and networking centre PIONEER (Polish Optical Internet, one of the most modern computer rooms in Poland)

Entertainment: Dr Jekyll and M. Hyde (film marathon), DJ Einstein (newest electronic concert, Poznan jazz musicians), Warta songs and dances (procession, dances, bonfire, along the Warta river bank), football cup at the moonlight, science cafés with researchers, reading of poems by researchers, bedtime stories by researchers (for children).
