Working group 1 – Evaluation

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I. General Background (recap)

Joint evaluations...

- ... were announced in the REFIT communication of 12 December 2012;
- 2 October 2013 communication on improving evaluation officially named the HLG on Better Regulation as the relevant forum.

A working group on evaluations was established in our meeting exactly a year ago.

November 2013 - February 2014: public consultation on Commission's draft new evaluation guidelines.



II. Steps / State of Play: Overview

- 1. Selection of projects / legislative acts for the joint evaluations (joint evaluation work "candidate")
- 2. Co-ordination with the responsible services at EU and then at Member State level
- 3. Evaluation work (the "dirty hands")

4. Drafting of the final report



- 1. Selection of projects / legislative acts for the joint evaluations (joint evaluation work "candidate")
 - Between the HLG meetings in April and October 2013: drafting of a short-list of possible evaluation candidates, together with the Commission.
 - The short-list contained 4 possible projects:
 - 1. General Food Law (fitness check)
 - 2. Waste (fitness check)
 - 3. Occupational Health and Safety (evaluation)
 - 4. Statistics (IntraStat)



- 1. Selection of projects / legislative acts for the joint evaluations (joint evaluation work "candidate")
 - 2 and 3 were at that time already at a quite advanced stage, with MS involvement at expert level.
 - 4 is part of ABR+.
 - Consideration had also to be given to limited capacities of the WG members, given the considerable work load to be expected from the joint evaluation.



- 1. Selection of projects / legislative acts for the joint evaluations (joint evaluation work "candidate")
 - So following our last meeting in October 2013 candidate 1 was opted for by the end of 2013: FC on General Food Law.
 - WG members were nonetheless invited, if interested, to contribute *individually* to 2 and 3 (by approaching their national responsible services).
