## Impact of participation in conferences

- 2011 Profiling: informed the further development of providing a more tailored approach to supports for the unemployed new profiling and case management approach
- 2012 Individual Action Planning: informed the development and design of individual action plans (Personal Progression Plans) and the application of sanctions for non-engagement



## Success factors for change

- Economic situation increased focus on activation and supporting people back into work
- Organisational change merger of employment and income supports
- Increased demand for services and supports
- Need to use all resources as efficiently as possible and ensure early intervention with those who most needed assistance in their return to work
- Ensure a tailored personalised approach
