Short description

The project addresses the employability of older workers according to a life cycle perspective making use of a participatory methodology to actively involve people and communities in identifying problems and solutions, formulating plans and implementing decisions at any stage of the project cycle. The specific objective of the project is to transfer innovation strategies in terms of: A) process, goal, context innovation and categories on which it is focused; B) local planning; C) networking promoted in the projects and operations of dissemination conducted to assure communication of the results. Key stakeholders involved in the policy network are older workers at risk of dismissal, social partners, local Government authorities, non-Governmental organisation (i.e. community groups, agencies). Main results expected: sharing of responsibilities with social partners; the involvement of local actors; to start implementing a local action plan.

Short description

The project aims to identify benchmarking tools and standards to support the implementation of public-private partnerships in employment services with special focus on services aimed at displaced workers, immigrants and ethnic minorities. The target groups of the project are the public and private institutions working in the field

of employment services at local, national and European level; public and private employment agencies providing employment services; employers, trade unions and bilateral bodies representatives, no- profit organisations, experts in labour law and industrial relations, experts in assessment of the employment performances, university researchers.
