# Posting of workers in the European Union and EFTA countries : Report on E101 certificates issued in 2008 and 2009

This note has been prepared in the frame of the work of the Administrative Commission for the coordination of social security systems and presented at its February 2011 meeting.

# 1. INTRODUCTION AND MAIN FINDINGS

This note briefly presents data on the number of E101 certificates issued in EU Member States and Iceland, Norway, Liechtenstein and Switzerland during 2008 and 2009. It is an update of the previous data collections covering reference years 2005 to 2007.

In the course of the latest data collection exercise during autumn 2010, DG Employment has requested and received data from all 27 EU Member States as well as Iceland, Lichtenstein, Norway and Switzerland. The data show the number of E101 certificates issued in these countries under Council Regulation (EC) No 1408/71 on the application of social security schemes to employed persons, to self-employed persons and to members of their families moving within the Community.

Almost all countries provided figures on E101 certificates issued for postings to specific Member States as well as cases linked to international transport, activities in 2 or more countries or other cases under the Regulation. Out of the 31 countries, 17 also provided a breakdown of data by sector of economic activity for 2009 (and 16 countries for 2008).

The data originate from administrative sources from countries' ministries for labour or social affairs or social security or social insurance authorities.

The main findings emerging from the 2008-09 data collection are the following:

- In 2009, a total of 1.29 million E101 certificates were recorded across the EU-27 and Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway and Switzerland. Of these, around 1.01 million related to postings to specific countries. The remainder of almost 279,000 cases fell into the categories international transport, persons active in 2 or more Member States or other cases. The overall figures for 2008 are very close.
- Almost two thirds of all postings originated in the EU-15 Member States (the Member States forming part of the EU before 1 May 2004) and around one third in the EU-12 Member States (that joined the EU in 2004 and 2007). Postings originating in EEA/CH accounted for about one percent of all postings.
- In 2009, the main sending countries of posted workers were France, Poland and Germany, followed by Luxembourg, the Netherlands, Belgium and Portugal. The main receiving countries were Germany, France, Belgium, the Netherlands and Spain.
- The data show a pattern of distribution of posted workers between sending and receiving countries which largely seems to follow geographical proximity.
- Compared to 2007, the data suggest some stagnation or even decrease in the number of postings, especially during 2009, most probably due to the economic recession in 2008 and 2009. In particular France, Poland and Germany sent significantly less posted workers abroad in 2009 than in 2007. During the same period, the only remarkable increase was recorded in the number of posted workers from Romania whereas their numbers also increased for Luxembourg, Spain, and Austria.
- Comparability over time is, however, somewhat limited by the variation in countries which reported postings. Nevertheless, overall and country specific results appear to be very consistent with the figures collected in the past.

- Concerning sectoral breakdown, the comparability and usefulness of the data is limited by the fact that for 2009, 14 countries (15 countries for 2008) did not provide figures by economic activity, including the three countries with the largest number of postings (PL, DE, FR) which represent more than half of all cases.
- The data from the 17 countries which did provide a sectoral breakdown in 2009 suggest that on average around 55% of E101 certificates issued were for industry (of which a less than half fall into the construction sector). This appears to be more than in 2007 when this share was about 45% (among almost the same group of reporting countries). The share of the E101 certificates issued for activities in the service sector is 44%, with only a limited part of it being for transport activities. Agriculture and fishing make for less than one percent of all certificates.
- The E101 data collection fills an important information gap concerning the posting of workers. To our knowledge, it is still the only source which allows for a comparable overview of the number of postings across EU-Member States. Moreover, compared to the previous data collections, coverage has significantly improved, especially for the most recent 2009 data.
- However, the usefulness and the quality of the data remain limited in a number of ways. The main limits have already been described in the last analysing note (from October 2009) and are recalled here : *The available data only provide the number of E101 certificates issued in each country, they do not contain any information concerning the duration of postings or the hours worked*. It is therefore not really possibly to use these figures to calculate the impact of postings on the level and structure of employment and wages in the sending and receiving countries. Moreover, a structural analysis of the labour market impact of postings is prevented by the lack of sectoral breakdown for the data of the main sending countries. In addition, further investigation is still necessary on the question to what extent the number of recorded E101 certificates cover the actual postings.
- Furthermore, there remain some data inconsistencies that would need to be clarified and/or corrected in the future.
- It is to be noted that, in order not to keep the text as concise as possible, the focus of the analysis below is on the reference year 2009 not only because it is more recent than 2008 but also because the quality of the data reported was better for that year. Moreover, the figures for 2008 are generally very close to the ones for 2009, except that we note a certain decrease from 2008 to 2009 for a number of countries, most probably due to the economic recession.

#### 2. OVERALL PICTURE OF 2008 AND 2009 DATA ON POSTED WORKERS

#### 2.1. E101 certificates by sending country




Figure 1a: Number of issued E101 certificates by sending country, 2008 (in 1,000)

- Figures 1a and 1b and tables 1a and 1b below show the number of E101 issued in each of the 31 reporting countries in 2008 and 2009. By showing postings to specific countries and E101 certificates issued for persons active in international transport, active in 2 or more Member States or other categories, these figures give the view from the side of the sending countries.
- In 2009, a total of 1.29 million E101 certificates were recorded across the EU-27 and Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway and Switzerland. Of these, around 1.01 million related to postings to specific countries. The remainder of almost 279,000 cases fell into the categories international transport, persons active in 2 or more Member States or other cases. The overall figures for 2008 are very close.
- In 2009, the main sending countries were France with 222,000 E101 certificates issued, followed by Poland (209,000), Germany (182,000). Five other countries LU, NL, BE, PT, and ES recorded a number of 50,000 E101 certificates or higher, while numbers in most other countries were substantially lower.
- Almost two thirds of all postings originated in the EU-15 Member States and around one third in the EU-12 Member States. Postings originating in EEA/CH accounted for about one percent of all postings.
- Among the E101 forms issued in the EU-15, around 61% were valid for other EU-15 countries, 5% for EU-12 countries, 7% for EFTA countries and 26% international transport, persons active in 2 or more Member States or other cases (Table 2b). Around 80% of E101 forms issued in the EU-12 were valid for EU-15 countries, 5% for other EU-12 countries, 3% for EFTA countries and 11% for multiple destinations and international transport.
- As for the EFTA countries, around 75% of E101 forms issued were for postings towards the EU and to other EFTA countries and 25% for international transport, persons active in 2 or more Member States or other cases (note that Switzerland did not provide figures disaggregated by destination country, thus not allowing for a meaningful breakdown by destination country for the EFTA total).
- For more detailed country breakdowns see **Tables 9 and 10** in the Annex.




Figure 1b: Number of issued E101 certificates by sending country, 2009 (in 1,000)

# 2.2. E101 certificates by destination countries

- ⇒ Under the E101 data collection exercise, countries were asked to provide data on how many E101 certificates were issued by their authorities for postings and other activities abroad, but not for data on workers posted to their territory from other countries. However, given that countries reported on the destination countries of those persons for whom they issued E101 certificates for postings one can calculate the number of posted workers to a specific destination country by summing up the corresponding numbers by sending country.




Figure 2a: Postings by destination country, 2008 (in 1,000)

- ⇒ By this count, the number of posted workers received in 2009 was highest in Germany (221,000), followed by France (156,000), Belgium (96,000), the Netherlands (82,000) and Spain (63,000) (see Figure 2b and table 3b). The other countries, having received between 25.000 and 55.000 posted workers in 2009 were Switzerland, Italy, Austria, the UK and Luxembourg.
- ⇒ Overall, around 64% of E101 forms valid for the EU-27 and EFTA were issued in EU-15 countries and 34% in EU-12 countries. Among the main receiving countries, the share of posted workers from the recently acceded Member States is rather low, with the exception of Germany, where around three quarters of posted workers came from the EU-12 (Table 4b).
- ⇒ Note, however, that in 2008, four countries (Bulgaria, Estonia, Sweden and Switzerland) did not provide a breakdown by destination country i.e. postings originating in these four countries cannot be allocated to any receiving country (the same occurs in 2009 for two countries: Sweden and Switzerland). However, postings from the non-reporting countries made for only 2.8 percent of total postings occurring in EU and EFTA in 2008 (and 1.6% in 2009). Also for the E101 certificates related to international transport, activity in 2 or more Member States or other cases, a breakdown by individual destination countries is not possible.




Figure 2b: Postings by destination country, 2009 (in 1,000)

# 2.3. Country by country distribution of postings

- ⇒ **Tables 9 and 10** of the annex show the detailed distribution of E101 forms between the 31 sending and receiving countries.
- ⇒ The figures show a rather clear pattern in the distribution of posted workers, which is extremely close to the situation for 2007 (described in the previous note 409/09 from October 2009). The country destination seems to follow geographical location and historical and business traditions, though some countries have one or two leading destinations, and some tend to spread the workers across several countries (see Table 5 below for a simplified presentation based on the 2009 situation):
  - Posted workers from *Belgium*, *France*, *Germany*, *Luxembourg* and *the Netherlands* spread into neighbouring countries: posted workers from Germany went mostly to Austria, the Netherlands, France, Belgium and Switzerland; from Belgium mainly to France and the Netherlands; from Luxembourg to France and Belgium; and from the Netherlands to Belgium and Germany (it should be noted that the Netherlands reported, both in 2008 and 2009, an extraordinarily high number of E101 certificates for persons active in 2 or more Member States which cannot be classified in any destination country).
  - Posted workers from *France* tended to go to Belgium, Germany, Italy, Spain, the UK and Switzerland.
  - Posted workers from *Austria* went mainly to Germany and Italy; from *Italy* to Switzerland and France; and those from *Liechtenstein* mostly to Austria.
  - Posted workers from *Iceland* tended to go to Portugal, Norway and Denmark; posted workers from *Norway* to the UK, Sweden and Denmark.
  - Main destinations for posted workers coming from *Denmark* are Norway and France and for those coming from *Finland*, it is Sweden and Germany.
  - Posted workers from the *UK* mainly tended to go to France, the Netherlands but also to Spain, while the ones from *Ireland* went mainly to Sweden, the Netherlands, Norway and the UK.
  - The main destinations for posted workers from *Portugal* were Spain and to a lesser extent France, while for those from Spain France was a major destination. For posted workers from *Greece* the main destination country was Germany.
  - *Cyprus* posted workers mainly to Greece and those from *Malta* mostly to the Netherlands and to a lesser extent to the UK.
  - Many posted workers from *Czech Republic*, *Hungary*, *Poland*, *Slovakia*, *Slovenia and Bulgaria* went to Germany. The secondary destinations of posted workers from these countries are France, Belgium, the Netherlands, Austria and Italy.
  - A main destination for posted workers from *Estonia* is Finland, while for those from *Latvia* and *Lithuania* it was Norway, Germany and Sweden.




- ⇒ Figures 3a and 3b gives an overview of the net balance of postings by country by showing the number of postings originating in a country (excluding E101 certificates issued for international transport, activity in 2 or more states and other cases) minus the number of postings received from other countries.
- ⇒ By this account, the Netherlands, Germany, Belgium and Switzerland were, both in 2008 and 2009, the countries who received the highest number of posted workers in net terms. It should be noted that the Netherlands reported, both in 2008 and 2009, an extraordinarily high number of E101 certificates for persons active in 2 or more Member States which cannot be classified in any destination country and taken into account for the net posting balance overview.
- ⇒ On the other hand, **Poland and Portugal** in 2009 (and Poland and France in 2008) were by far the main sending countries.

# 3. COMPARISON WITH 2007 DATA




Figure 4: Postings by sending country, 2007 - 2009 (in thousand)

- ⇒ Figure 4 and table 6 show a comparison of E101 certificates issued in the reporting countries in the years 2007, 2008 and 2009.
- ⇒ Note that comparison is made with 2007 data but not with previous (2005-06) years since the method of data collection (in particular the questionnaire) had been modified for the 2007 exercise and that the quality and completeness of the data was therefore better than in the past.
- ⇒ Compared to 2007, the data suggest some overall stagnation of the number of E101 certificates and even a decrease in the number of postings to specific countries, most probably due to the economic recession in 2008 and 2009. It is to be noted that, if one takes into account the significant underreporting of the number of postings sent by Portugal for 2008 (and to a lesser extent Sweden), it appears that the decline in the number of postings took place mostly during 2009. In particular France, the UK and Poland sent significantly less posted workers abroad in 2009 though this trend had already started in 2008. The evolution for France is particularly striking with a decline from 232.000 posted workers sent in 2007 to 161.000 in 2009.
- ⇒ From 2007 to 2009, the only remarkable increase was recorded in the number of posted workers from Romania (from 9.000 to 26.000) whereas their numbers also increased for Luxembourg, Spain, and Austria.




Figure 5: Postings by destination country, 2007 - 2009 (in thousand)

- ⇒ Figure 5 and table 7 show a comparison of postings by destination country between 2007 and 2009.
- ⇒ Compared to the picture by sending country, a comparison over time by receiving country is a bit more problematic due to the variation of countries which reported the countries of destination. However, as they never represent more than 3% of the total (see section 2.2), the comparison remains essentially valid.
- ⇒ The comparison over time by destination country shows a rather stable pattern in the order of main destination countries. From 2007 to 2009, the following trends can however be noted: strong increase in the number of posted workers received for Switzerland (from 29,000 to 52,000) and to a lesser extent in Bulgaria, Slovakia and Austria; on the contrary, a decrease is recorded in Spain, Belgium, Norway and Denmark.

Figures for postings originate in Germany relate, for 2008 data to 1 January 2008 to 30 November 2008 and for 2009 data to 1 January 2009 to 30 November 2009. Figures for postings originating in Portugal in 2008 are underestimated since only 6 of the 18 district centres of social security provided the data. Figures for postings originating in Italy, the 2007 figures were underestimated as they covered only the last months of the year (the electronic processing of E101 started in the second part of 2007).

#### 4. BREAKDOWN BY SECTOR OF ECONOMIC ACTIVITY

- $\Rightarrow$  **Table 8** shows the sectoral distribution of E101 certificates for the 17 countries which provided data by sector breakdown in 2009.
- ⇒ Due to the fact that many countries (including France, Poland and Germany as the by far most important sending countries) did not provide a breakdown by economic activity conclusions on the distribution of posted workers by sectors of economic activity are rather difficult.
- ⇒ The data from those countries which did provide a sectoral breakdown suggest that on average in 2009 around 55% of E101 certificates issued were for industry (of which less than half fall into the construction sector). This appears to be more than in 2007 when this share was about 45% among almost the same group of reporting countries. The share of the E101 certificates issued for activities in the service sector, at 44%, is consequently lower than in 2007 (54%) with a decline particularly pronounced for transport activities (mainly due to biased figures used in 2007). Agriculture and fishing make for less than one percent of all certificates.
- ⇒ It is to be noted that the sector nomenclature used for the latest data collection exercise was still the old NACE 1.1 classification (valid until 2008). As for the future, it would be advisable to use the revised NACE 2 classification.

#### 5. STRENGTHS AND WEAKNESSES OF THE E101 DATA

- ⇒ The E101 data collection fills an important information gap concerning the posting of workers. To our knowledge, it is still the only source which allows for a comparable overview of the number of postings across EU-Member States. Moreover, compared to the previous data collections, coverage has significantly improved.
- $\Rightarrow$  DG Employment therefore recommends to continue this exercise in the future.
- ⇒ However, the usefulness and the quality of the data remain limited in a number of ways. We repeat here the main limits already pointed in the previous analysis note prepared in October 2009 :
  - While almost all countries have now transmitted figures broken down by destination country, data from four countries in 2008 and two countries in 2009 still lacked such a breakdown and therefore prevented the calculation of a complete sending by destination country matrix.
  - At a more methodological level, the available data only provide the number of E101 certificates issued in each country, but do not contain any information on the duration of postings or the hours worked. In other words, the present data are not really an indicator for labour input. It is therefore not possibly to use these figures to calculate the impact of postings on the level and structure of employment and wages in the sending and receiving countries.
  - Moreover, a structural analysis of the labour market impact of postings is prevented by the lack of sectoral breakdown for the data of the main sending countries and a general lack of detail by economic activity. While postings tend to concentrate on a few specific activities (e.g. construction, cleaning services), the available data are not detailed enough to allow any deeper analysis.
  - In addition, there is still some uncertainty to what extent the number of E101 certificates recorded by countries is a precise proxy of the actual number of postings taking place. Firstly, it is not known how many E101 certificates translate into actual postings. Secondly, there is no information on undocumented postings, i.e. workers who are posted by their employers without having applied for an E101 form.
- ⇒ Some of these limitations can be addressed by further improving the coverage of the present data collection exercise. Other limitations, in particular concerning labour input, sector detail or undocumented postings would require a further investigation, for example based on country specific sources on the inflow of posted workers by individual sector.
  - Furthermore, a number of data inconsistencies need to be clarified with some reporting countries.
