Project summary					

To get a job you need a network. And you have to use that network to the outmost. With „your first EURES job“ the targeted groups will get a larger network and opportunities all over Europe.

Since the start of the crisis in 2007 the unemployment of youngsters between the ages of 18 and 30 has risen to new heights and many European countries are on the verge of losing an entire generation of young unemployed under 30 because they are having trouble finding foothold on the labour market. The economic recovery has remained fragile. Although the European labour market is improving and showing signs of recovery in some EU Member States, the situation is still weak and difficult especially for young people.

The aim of this project is to provide guidance, job searching, recruitment and financial help to youngsters between 18 and 30 being willing to use the job opportunities in another EU-country. It's also an aim to guide and assist SMEs in recruiting young European candidates between 18 and 30.

Candidates for each job get job interviews with employers in either the countries in the network of this project or online. .

The young people will get the opportunities to meet different challenges and opportunities - from countries with a high degree of unemployment to countries with lack of labour in certain areas. They will have opportunities in many different branches and joblines and thereby also get the ability to specialize in specific work areas, which will also provides an opportunity to cope future bottlenecks in the various specialized areas.

The EURES organizational unit will be located in the Employment Department, to ensure that the skills and coaching is available. The project will use tools based on:

- Existing knowledge on the labour market, employment structure and the educational structure
- Existing methods in the employment efforts in Denmark and in other EU countries
- Existing knowledge about mobility and job opportunities in Europe

Project summary					

The action is aimed at achieving permanent cooperation bridges among different kinds of organizations dealing with activities related with job matching and job placement to eliminate bottlenecks in the job of European SMEs and helping young people aged 18 to 30 yo to work in another EU state.

The Spanish PES will work in cooperation in YFEJ- Permanent Cooperation Bridges to reinforce the activities of the Spanish EURES network with the objective of proving the added value of financial support to jobseekers and SMEs employers in the field of placements.

Youth unemployment rates highlight the contrast among some Member States, with rates below 8% in Austria and the Netherlands, and 44.4% in Spain. These figures empower us to participate in any project devoted to promote employment for young people. Our main mission will be the provision of employment services to young jobseekers and SMEs. We have solid experience in recruitment, job matching and job placement activities developed as part of EURES network and reinforced last year with specific activities programs on permanent cooperation bridges for employment mobility.

The implementation and evaluation on Spanish YFEJ proposal will give us the possibility to measure in which extend provide financial support could be an extra help to ensure fair mobility in EU. On the other hand, the Spanish YFEJ proposal will give more visibility to EURES activities being a way to systematize the results of recruitments, the number of contracts, companies and jobseekers involved in these actions. The Spanish YFEJ proposal will be carry out by different PES at regional level with the coordination of a team at national level, ensuring the capacity to distribute low-value grants to young European mobile jobseekers and recruiting SMEs. According to different resources, online job demand showed an annual increase of +21% which encourage developing new strategies supported by online tools as EURES portal, social networks and ICT tools

Promoted by a consortium of three organisations (Provincia di Roma, general employment service and member of the Eures network, Asset Camera, special Agency of the Chamber of Commerce of Rome and HUSCIE paneuropean network of NGOs), Eures Job for Youth (EJY) fosters mobility and professional development of EU young job seekers provide innovative views, new skills and knowledge to smes, thanks to an energetic and motivated young worker ζ coming from another EU country - who will contribute to his/her business.

It will implement at least 500 job placement across different member state with a special focus to the following countries: Italy, Germany, Portugal, Ireland, Spain, The Netherlands and Sweden - where face to face desks will be implemented, but open to all 27 EU countries with incoming and outgoing mobility dependent on labour demand and supply opportunities.

Both young job seekers and smes will receive client centered services designed to respond to the individual need of youth facing barriers to employment and job mobility and of smes facing barriers to hiring abroad: practical and financial assistance, such as match-making, issuing contracts, induction before going abroad, logistical and local support during the stay; follow up assessment. A social media marketing campaign and focused networking activities with relevant EU stakeholders will enhance project effectiveness and added value. This latter activity, complementing the Commission ζs one, will support information broadcasting of EU job opportunities for young people and skill offer for smes.
