3. AREA OF INTERVENTION:

Gender Equality in Sport

4. SPECIFIC OBJECTIVE(S):

- To increase representation by women in leadership positions in sport
- To build the competence and confidence of women in decision-making positions
- To increase support among organizations for the contribution women can make to sports leadership
- To strengthen networking between women leaders, both nationally and internationally
- To provide a platform for future national and international projects
- To disseminate best practice via website, publications, sharing seminars and international networks

The project is aimed at women's access to decision-making positions in sport. The programme will train future women leaders, provide an information platform to help create future projects and analyse the current status of women in leadership positions in sport. Also the project aims at providing a multi-media platform from which partner countries can continue training programmes long after the initial project is completed.

5. DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT:

The project will provide training courses for potential women's sport leaders held both nationally and at a European level; the modules are designed to provide training in the skills needed for anyone to become a board member or hold senior positions both nationally and at European level. Participants will also be designed mentors to help answer questions, provide additional opportunities to their mentees and to provide support long after the project has finished.

6. ACTIVITIES TO BE COMPLETED AS PART OF THE PROJECT:

- Training courses for potential women's leaders
- Creation of a website to act as a project tool and library for future projects,

- Literature outlining how the program functions
- Analysis of the project for future reference,
- Hosting events and discussions in the European Parliament
- Linking events through ENGSO with other international organisations,
- Seminars will be organized for organizations for other countries in order for them to find out about the project.

Evaluation of skills and the survey will have to be done nationally, and partners will have responsibility for collecting information. Collation of data and analysis will be done by CCPR, EWS and through independent analysis.

The short term success of the project will depend on up-skilling prospective women leaders and producing a transferable framework for future learning programmes, while the long term success will mean women progressing to leadership positions in sport.
