Further, the aim is to develop the DC-sport network so it is able to gather the needs of and challenges facing young athletes from organizations that are involved in sports training and education.

The main target groups for the networks are sports organizations of any juridical form, size, sport and location in Europe.

### **6. ACTIVITIES TO BE COMPLETED AS PART OF THE PROJECT:**

The project proposal includes:

- research and studies intended for making methods and tools for sports organizations that facilitate the internal needs analysis and the exchange of best practices.
- conduct research on existing best practices and their context for young athletes.

- Research on methods and courses of action that facilitate identification and classification of best practices will be conducted.
- Needs analysis will be done regarding the education and training for young athletes and their areas of professionalism, education and training paths will be mapped. Methods and techniques for the needs analysis will be developed to match each organization.
- Management (project management and coordination by Boson college)
- mapping and segmentation of target groups, production of "key selling points" adapted to each segment, setting up of a dissemination activity plan, production of promotional materials and activities according to the plan, evaluation of the effects of the dissemination,
- Creation of a new European platform for sharing knowledge, dissemination and exploitation of good practice in education and sport)
