We would like to invite you to the 6th meeting of the Expert Group on the Mobility of Young Volunteers across the EU. We are pleased to inform you that the Polish Presidency will kindly host the meeting in Warsaw.

The meeting will take place on **27 October 2011 from 9.30 – 15.30h**. The morning session will be held at the Ministry of National Education, at Szucha Avenue 25, in the conference room no. 102 (1st floor). After lunch the Polish hosts will invite us to visit volunteering projects. At 15.30h we will be back at the Ministry from where you can directly go to the airport, if you wish.

We have put together an interesting programme for you, which will inform us on recent activities in the Czech Republic, in Germany and the UK. An important part of the meeting will be a **tour de table**, where we will **ask you to update** all of us **about the implementation** of the Recommendation on the Mobility of Young Volunteers **in your countries**.

As you know, we can only reimburse **one representative per country** (whether official or NGO).
