Subject: Ninth meeting of the expert group on peer-learning


We are pleased to invite you to take part in the next meeting of the expert group on peer-learning on **17-18 March 2014 in London (from 11:00 – 18:00; and 9:00 – 18h)**. The meeting will take place in **the Doubletree by Hilton Hotel, London Ealing, 2-8 Hanger Lane, London W5 3HN** and will be kindly hosted by the British Council. The working language will be English and there will be no interpretation.

The meeting aims to further analyse the peer learning group's recommendations in order to provide inputs to a larger Cross-sectoral seminar that the Commission will organise in Brussels later in the year. This seminar follows a request from the Council of Youth Ministers that asked a seminar involving the key policy areas of Youth, Education and Training and Employment, and relevant stakeholders, to examine the optimum manner in which a collaborative policy response to the current challenges facing young people could be progressed. This upcoming meeting of the expert group will allow the experts to discuss with people with expertise and influence in a number of sectors (including SMEs, business, creative industries, arts and culture, sports and leisure, formal education, public and voluntary sectors) with a direct interest in young people and employment issues.
