MINUTES CARE MEETING 6 FEBRUARY 2014

1. CARE and CADas Developments

EC presented the last developments on the CARE database and on the CaDAS datamodel. Several improvements have been implemented to improve performances. A discussion on the needs to change vehicle type definition has started and no decision has been taken. The Care newsletter has been presented to the experts and it was welcome. A presentation on the use of coordinates of accidents has shown a great interest on participates, especially the possibility to link with the TEN network.

2. Eurostat

EUROSTAT has presented the new common questionnaire for transport and have underlined the good cooperation between the 3 organizations on charge (UNECE, ITF and EUROSTAT). The questionnaire is decreasing the administrative burden on MS. Care data are now publish on Eurobase

3. Injuries severity

Several member states have already started the process to have data on road injuries with the new definition, having data from hospitals could take quite a long time due to different problems, as for example inability of national database, not use of international codification of disseises or problems links to privacy or confidentiality. Most of the countries expressed the opinion that link hospitals and police data would be a very difficult task and in some cases impossible. The Commission advices using hospital data and encourage the linking when possible.

4. Training

2 half days optional training have been organized the day before and after the meeting and we will continue with the same schema on the future.
