## Summary report FARM ACCOUNTANCY DATA NETWORK (FADN) EXPERT GROUP

**Date:** Tuesday, 20 May 2014 (from 09.30 to 10.30)

**Present**: 26 Member States were present. Cyprus, Greece were absent.

1. Adoption of the minutes of the previous meeting of the Expert Group on 11<sup>th</sup> April 2014. The minutes were adopted without comments or questions from the experts.

# 2. State of play of a working document regarding a Delegated Act supplementing Council Regulation (EC) No 1217/2009 of 30 November 2009 setting up a network for the collection of accountancy data on the incomes and business operation of agricultural holdings in the European Union.

The Commission presented the working document for the Delegated Act supplementing Council Regulation (EC) No 1217/2009 in its current form, in order to inform the experts about the preparation of the draft delegated act text. The presentation highlighted changes to the document since the previous meeting with the experts. The Commission informed that the document is in a pre-consultation phase with the Legal Service, and that the introduced changes are of legal, linguistic or clarification nature. Next, the document will be put to an inter service consultation within the Commission (with the Legal Service, DG Budget, Eurostat) with the aim of adopting the text of the Delegated Act by the Commission in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half of July 2014. That text will then be submitted to the European Parliament and the Council. If these two institutions do not object to the text within a period 2 months (which may be extended by them by another 2 months), then the Commission will be in a position to publish it. Also, finalisation of the FADN implementing act may then take place under the examination procedure with the FADN committee. The two acts, the delegated one and the implementing one, will then be published on the same date in order to provide the FADN network with a complete legal framework.
