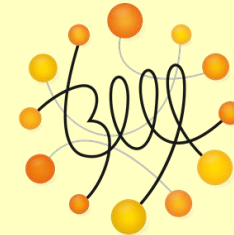

Adult Education in Germany

❖ Political Responsibility

- ✓ According to the “constitution” the Basic Law of the Federal Republic of Germany (Grundgesetz):
 - “All cultural and educational issues are decided by the individual Federal States autonomously”.

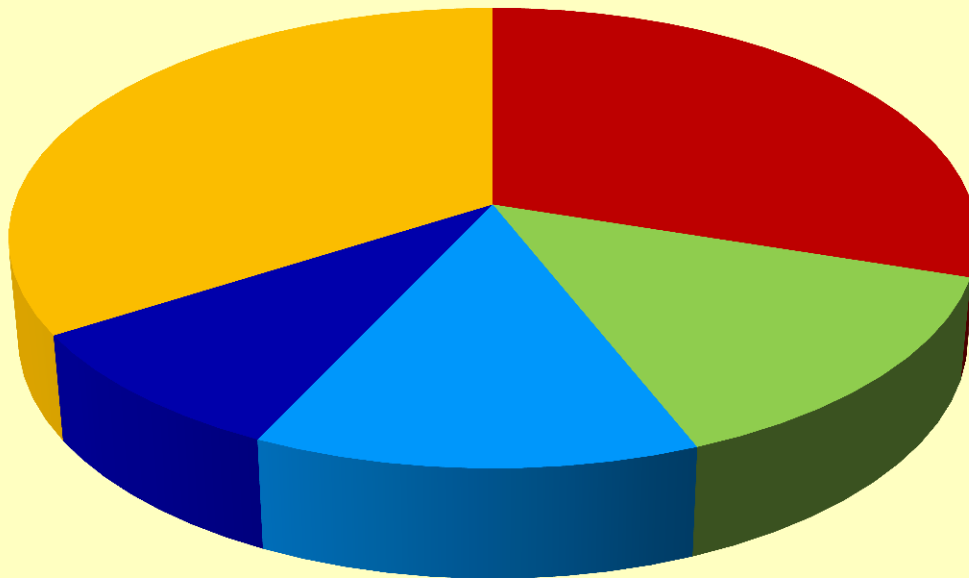
That means:

- ✓ Each state in Germany is responsible for forming and implementing its own educational policy!

in %

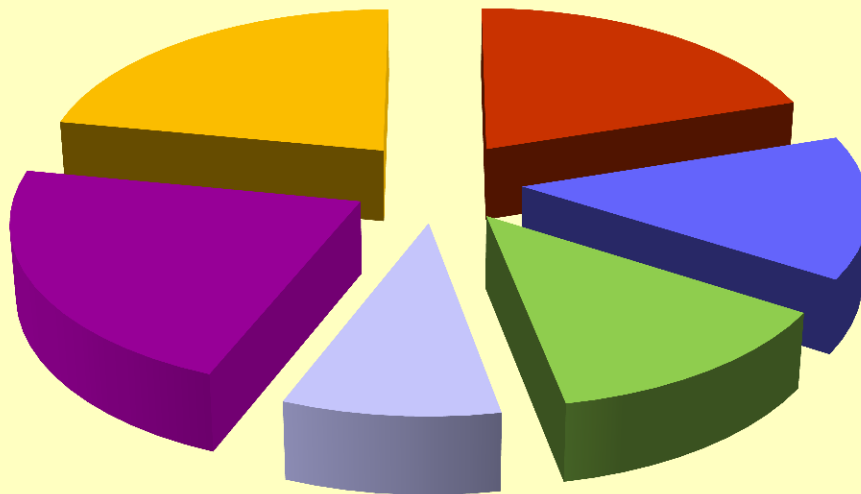


- Adult education centers (VHS) - 30%
- Associations - 14%
- Private institutes - 13%
- Employers companies - 9%
- Misc (e.g. church or union run centers) - 34%

❖ Special target groups

low-skilled workers, (female) returner, migrants, people without a school-leaving qualification, seniors (50+), illiterates, people with disabilities

❖ Working focus

Lifelong learning projects for low-skilled people, (financial) support, innovation, consulting, realization and implementation of new (cooperation) programs, continuing education networking, LLL-marketing, flexible learning with new multi-media instruments

❖ Goals

Develop and implement a comprehensive lifelong strategy and improve the quality of education and vocational training, strengthening links with labour market needs, and further encourage the social partners to adopt a more active and constructive role in this subject.
